SUBSIDIARY FOODSTUFFS

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950
Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Pararajasegarampillai Thambiah, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for Vavuniya District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Price Order No. V. 47, dated 20th June, 1958, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,378 of 25th June, 1958, in so far as it relates to the maximum wholesale price and the retail dealers maximum retail price mentioned therein for Dried Fish;
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per cwt. nett, a retail dealer's maximum retail price per pound nett to a consumer respectively above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;

(iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

- (a) any sale of any quantity of Dried Fish or Dried Prawns for the purpose of re-sale, or any sale of any Dried Fish or Dried Prawns in a quantity of one hundred weight nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (b) any sale of Dried Fish or Dried Prawns in a quantity less than one hundred weight nett for any purpose other than re-sale shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (c) the "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;
- (d) "Dried Fish" shall be deemed to be the same as "Dry Fish";

(iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell Dried Fish or Dried Prawns of the description specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article;

(v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle any Dry Fish or Dried Prawns of the description specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at that place or on that vehicle, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for such article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule fixed by this Order in that area;

(vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or lb. shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;

(vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells by wholesale any Dried Fish or Dried Prawns specified in column 1 of the First Schedule shall, and every person who sells by retail any Dried Fish or Dried Prawns specified in column 1 of the First Schedule by wholesale shall and every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the same Schedule by retail shall on demand give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of sale;
- (b) the description of the article sold;
- (c) the gross and the nett weight of the quantity sold;
- (d) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
- (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;

(viii) direct that the maximum wholesale and maximum retail prices referred to in columns 2 and 3 of the First Schedule hereto shall include the price of wrapper if any in which such article is sold;

(ix) direct that in any sale of any Dried Fish specified in column 1 of the Schedules hereto, other than Kumbalawa, Bombili, Halmasso and Dried Prawns in containers the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a minimum tare of ten pounds per container;

(x) direct that in any sale of Kumbalawa specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, in containers the sale price shall

- be calculated on gross weight less a minimum tare of twenty-five pounds per container;
- (xi) direct that in any sale of Bombili specified in column 1 of the Schedules hereto, in containers the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a minimum tare of eight pounds per container;
- (xii) direct that in any sale of Halmasso specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, in containers the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a minimum tare of twenty-pounds per container;
- (xiii) direct that in any sale of Dried Prawns without shell or Dried Prawns with shell

- specified in column 1 of the Schedules hereto in containers the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a minimum tare of fifteen pounds;
- (xiv) direct that for the purpose of this Order "nett" shall mean gross weight less tare or naked weight of Dried Fish or Dried Prawns.

DRIED FISH AND DRIED PRAWNS
THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Anton Rothwell McHeyzer, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Trincomalee District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. T/8/58, dated June 27, 1958, and published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,405 of July 1, 1958;
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the First Schedule hereto to be the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett, the retail dealer's maximum price per pound nett and the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett respectively above which Dried Fish and Dried Prawns of the description given in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the First Schedule shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned at the head of columns 2, 3 and 4 of the First Schedule;
- (iii) fix the prices for the time being fixed by me under column 3 of the First Schedule as the maximum retail price per pound nett within the Trincomalee Urban Council area increased by the amounts specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule to be the maximum retail price per pound nett above which Dried Fish and Dried Prawns of the description given under column 1 of the First Schedule shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of Dried Fish or Dried Prawns for purpose of re-sale, or any sale of any Dried Fish or Dried Prawns in a quantity of one hundred-weight nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of Dried Fish or Dried Prawns in a quantity less than one hundredweight nett for any purpose other than re-sale shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (c) "wholesale dealer" shall mean any person who is in the habit of selling Dried Fish or Dried Prawns by wholesale;
 - (d) "the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price" fixed for sale by this Order shall apply to the sale by wholesale of any article by wholesale dealer to a retail dealer;
 - (e) the "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;
 - (f) "Dried Fish" shall be deemed to be the same as "Dry Fish";
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell Dried Fish or Dried Prawns of the description given in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader who has in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle any Dried Fish or Dried Prawns of the description specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of that article;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order, "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells by wholesale any Dried Fish or Dried Prawns specified in column 1 of the First Schedule shall, and every person who sells by retail any Dried Fish or Dried Prawns specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto shall on demand give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale;
 - (b) the description of the articles sold;
 - (c) the gross and the nett weight of the quantity sold;
 - (d) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (ix) direct that when any Dried Fish or Dried Prawns specified in column 1 of the First Schedule is sold the maximum prices referred to in this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or the container, if any, in which such article is sold;
- (x) direct that in any sale of any Dried Fish specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto, other than Kumbalawa, Bombili, Halmasso and Dried Prawns in containers the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a minimum tare of ten pounds per container;
- (xi) direct that in any sale of Kumbalawa specified in column 1 of First Schedule in containers the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a minimum tare of twenty-five pounds per container;
- (xii) direct that in any sale of Bombili specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto in containers the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less the minimum tare of 8 pounds per container;
- (xiii) direct that in any sale of Halmasso specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto in containers the sale price shall

be calculated on gross weight less a minimum tare of twenty pounds per container;

(xiv) direct that in any sale of Dried Prawns without shell or Dried Prawns with shell specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto in containers the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a minimum tare of fifteen pounds;

(xv) direct that for the purpose of this Order "nett" shall mean gross weight less tare or naked weight of Dried Fish or Dried Prawns.
