THE TOWN COUNCILS ORDINANCE, No. 3 OF 1946

Special Conservancy Rate for 1959

IT is hereby notified that each Town Council specified in column I of the Schedule hereto has, under section 143 (b) of the Town Councils Ordinance, No. 3 of 1946, and with the sanction of the Minister of Local Government and Cultural Affairs given by virtue of the powers vested in him by that section, as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, imposed for the year 1959, subject to such limits and exemptions as may be prescribed by by-laws, a special conservancy rate on the annual value of all immovable property situated within that town, such rate being that specified in the corresponding entry in column II of that Schedule and payable in four equal instalments on March 31, June 30, September 30 and December 31, respectively.
