THIS is an award under section 24 of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131, of the Legislative Enactments, Ceylon (Revised Edition, 1956), as amended by the Industrial Disputes (Amendment) Acts, No. 14 of 1957, No. 62 of 1957, and No. 4 of 1962.

The Honourable the Minister of Labour and Nationalised Services, by his Order dated 21st May, 1962, made under section 4 (2) of the aforesaid Act, referred the dispute between the Associated Newspapers of Ceylon, Limited (hereinafter referred to as the "Company"), and the United Mercantile Employees' Union (hereinafter referred to as the "Union") to this Court for settlement. According to the statement of the Acting Commissioner of Labour dated 9th May, 1962, which accompanied the Minister's Order, the matters in dispute between the parties were :—

- (i) whether the change of status of Mrs. C. V. J. Samaraweera from Librarian to Assistant Librarian is justified, and to what relief she is entitled; and
- (ii) whether Mrs. C. V. J. Samaraweera had been placed on a salary scale applicable to the post she was holding and, if not, to what relief she is entitled.

2. At the inquiry before me held on the 16th June, 1962, Mr. Advocate S. Nadesan, Q. C. with Mr. Advocate M. Rafeek and Mr. Advocate N. Satyendra, instructed by Mr. C. S. de Seneviratne, appeared for the Company, and Mr. Vernon de Livera, President of the Union, appeared for the Union.

3. After the parties have stated their respective positions through their representatives, Mrs. Samaraweera gave evidence. Her evidence was continued on the 18th June, 1962, and in the

course of her cross-examination the parties arrived at the following Settlement :—

- (1) Mrs. C. V. J. Samaraweera tenders her resignation to the Company operative as from today (18th June, 1962), and the Company accepts it.
- (2) In view of the special circumstances of this case, the Company agrees to pay Mrs. Samaraweera, her full salary and allowances for the month of June, 1962, and also to give her an *ex-gratia* payment of nine months salary and allowances based on the salary and allowances for the month of June, 1962.

4. I consider that the settlement arrived at between the parties is a just and equitable one, and make my award accordingly.

5. In accordance with the settlement arrived at, Mrs. Samaraweera handed over her written resignation to the Company.

6. With regard to the question of the monies due to Mrs. Samaraweera from the Lake House Provident and Benefit Funds raised by Mr. Livera, Mr. Nadesan said that the Company does not have control of these Funds, and that the monies due from those Funds will be paid to her in accordance with the rules of those Funds now that she has resigned. Mr. Livera stated that Mrs. Samaraweera has no further claims against the Company.
