INDUSTRIAL COURT AT COLOMBO

The Award

THIS is an award under section 24 of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments, Ceylon (Revised Edition, 1956), as amended by the Industrial Disputes (Amendment) Acts, Nos. 14 and 62 of 1957, and No. 4 of 1962. It relates to an industrial dispute between the United Engineering Workers' Union, 123, Union Place, Colombo 2 (hereinafter referred to as the "Union"), and the C. F. T. Engineering Limited, 467, Union Place, Colombo 2 (hereinafter referred to as the "Company").

2. The Honourable the Minister of Labour and Nationalised Services, by his Order dated 30th April, 1962; made under section 4 (2) of the aforesaid Act, referred the dispute to this Court for settlement. The matter in dispute as specified by the Acting Commissioner of Labour in his statement annexed to the reference dated 23rd April, 1962, is the claim made by the aforesaid Union on behalf of its members at the C. F. T. Engineering Limited for the payment of wages, dearness allowance and annual increments on the basis set out in the Collective Agreement No. 1 of 1959, and published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 11,752 dated 29th May, 1959. At the inquiry held before us on the 10th of July, 1962, Mr. N. Sanmugathasan, General Secretary of the Ceylon Trade Union Federation, appeared for the Union, and Mr. H. M. Fernando, Accountant of the Company, appeared for the Company.

3. After Mr. Sanmugathasan, has stated the position of the Union, Mr. Fernando, the Accountant, gave evidence and produced the audited Balance Sheets and Profit and Loss Accounts as well as the Trading Accounts for the year ending 31st March, 1953, and for the years following up to the year ending 31st March, 1961. The position of the Company was that it had been suffering heavy losses during this period, and that if it has to pay dearness allowance in terms of the Collective Agreement of 1959, it will cost the Company more than Rs. 33,600 annually, which amount the Company cannot now afford to pay as an extra expense on account of those losses, and that if they had to pay, it would be necessary to retrench staff, and that it will not be possible to carry on for long.

4. The inquiry was thereupon postponed for the 23rd of July, in order that the Union may study these Accounts and decide what position the Union should adopt. When the inquiry was taken up on the 23rd July, the Court was informed that the parties had come to a settlement of the dispute in the following terms:—

"The Union withdraws its demand without any prejudice to its right to re-raise it at a future date when it feels that the Company is in a better position to meet its demand. The Company agrees to pay an extra allowance of 40 cents per working day per worker as from the 1st of August, 1962; this allowance to be additional to the cost of living allowance now fixed by the Wages Board.

5. We consider the settlement arrived at is a reasonable one, especially in view of the fact that the documents produced show that the Company has been running at a great loss over a period of years. We are satisfied that the agreement arrived at is in the interests of both parties. We therefore make our award accordingly.
