OTICE is hereby given that, in accordance with the provisions of "The Branch Roads Ordinance, 1896," a general meeting of the proprietors or resident managers of the estates interested in the Nugetenna-Kobonila road, for the making of which a vote of Rs. 13.500 has been passed by the Legislative Council, will be held at Waitalawa bungalow on Saturday, January 16, 1897, at 12 noon, for the purpose of electing a Local Committee to perform the duties imposed upon such as aid committee by the Ordinance.

The general meeting for the election of the Local Committee must consist of such number of proprietors or resident managers within the district as shall represent not less than one-third of the acreage.
