MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, January 15, 1897.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated January 9, 1897.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Mr. R. D. Ormsby; Mr. A. Forsyth; Brigade-Surgeon Lieut.-Col. A. W. Duke; Mr. H. van Cuylenburg; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of December 11, 1896, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of December 11, 1896, be confirmed.

1-3. The following motions standing in Mr. C. P. Dias's name were withdrawn by leave of Council:—

- (1) To present a petition from Mr. A. M. Mohamado Sahi, of No. 94, Old Moor street.
- (2) To move that it be read and considered.
- (3) To move that the Inspector of Buildings be asked to inspect and report upon insanitary buildings in crowded localities in the St. Sebastian Ward before the next Meeting of the Council; and that steps be taken to make their sanitary condition as perfect as is practicable under existing circumstances, and thereby render it impossible for them to become centres of infection.

4. The Council then proceeded to ballot for the election of five Members to form a Standing Committee for 1897.

The result of the ballot was declared by the Chairman to be in favour of Hon. Sir W. R. Kynsey, Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. C. M. Fernando, and Mr. C. P. Dias, who were accordingly elected to form a Standing Committee for 1897.
