MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, March 12, 1897.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated March 6, 1897.

Present.—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Hon. Sir W. R. Kynsey, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Brigade-Surgeon Lieut.-Col. A. W. Duke; Mr. F. Bois; Mr. H. van Cuylenburg; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of February 12, 1897, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of February 12, 1897, be confirmed.

1. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to February 28, 1897, and a Progress Report of work done during February, 1897, were laid on the table.

2. A letter No. 22 of February 23, 1897, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding a return of applications for water service, was laid on the table with connected papers, having been previously circulated amongst Members.

3. A letter No. 16 of February 9, 1897, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to a proposal to levy a tax for the removal of night soil from private premises, was laid before the Council with connected papers, having been previously circulated.

Mr. Walter Pereira moved "that the receipt of the letter be acknowledged with thanks, and that steps be taken to carry out the suggestions contained in paragraph 2 thereof."

Lieut.-Col. Duke seconded.

Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne moved as an amendment "that all the words in the motion after the word 'thanks' be deleted."

Mr. Walter Pereira then moved "that the tax which the Municipal Council suggests to meet the cost of the removal of night soil from private houses and buildings be a rate on the annual value of houses and buildings as that mentioned in section 127 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, 7 of 1887."

Lieut.-Col. Duke seconded.

This motion was, by leave of Council, withdrawn.

4. An application from the Honorary Secretary, Sports Club, for permission to enclose three sides of the Club's cricket ground was laid before the Council, having been previously circulated.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved "that the application be allowed, provided that the fence does not exceed 4 ft. in height, and that it is to be removed on notice being given by the Council."

Mr. Alvis seconded.—Carried.

5. The Sanitary Officer's Report for fourth quarter, 1896, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

6. A letter from the Head Printer, Mr. Wahid, withdrawing his application for four months' leave of absence was laid on the table.

7. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for October, 1896, were laid on the table.

8. The City Analyst's report on the town water for February, 1897, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

9. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gunpowder were laid on the table.
