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MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, May 14, 1897.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated May 8, 1897.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; the Hon. Sir W. R. Kynsey, Kr. C.M.G.; Brigade-Surgeon Lieut.-Col A. W. Duke; Mr. F. Bois; Mr. H. van Cuylenburg; Mr. F. H. Grinlinton; the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. C. Perera; the Hon. Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; and Mr. C. P. Dias.

The Minutes of April 9, 1897, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of April 9, 1897, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice, the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne moved "that the Council make a contribution to the

funds required for the celebration of the Diamond Jubilee of Her Majesty."

This motion was, by leave of Council, amended as follows:—"That the Council do make a contribution to the funds required for the celebration of the Diamond Jubilee of Her Majesty as follows: a sum of Rs. 2,000 towards the permanent memorial; a sum of Rs. 500 for feeding the poor; and a sum of Rs. 500 for illuminations, fireworks, and

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. C. P. Dias and carried unanimously.

2. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera moved "that an address of congratulation be presented to Her Majesty the Queen on the occasion of the Diamond Jubilee of Her Majesty's reign.

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This motion was, by leave of Council, amended by the addition of the words "and that the Chairman be authorized to incur the necessary expenses."

The motion so amended was seconded by the Hon. Mr. P. Coomaraswamy and carried unanimously.

A draft address was then read and adopted.

3. The following recommendation from the Standing Committee of May 7, 1897, was laid before the Council:—

7) Application from the lessee of Edinburgh market to cancel the lease. Resolved that the Council be recommended to cancel the lease.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the recommendation contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee of May 7, 1897, be adopted."

The Hon. Mr. P. Coomarswamy seconded.—Carried unanimously.

4. A letter No. 36, dated April 5, 1897, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the permission granted to the Sports Club by the Municipal Council to enclose three sides of the Club's cricket ground at Galle Face was laid before the Council with connected papers.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the erection of a bamboo fence, not exceeding 4 ft. in height, and subject to summary removal as suggested by the Municipal Council, will in the opinion of the Council be unobjectionable, and that the Government be recommended to grant (in conjunction with the Military authorities) the permission applied for."

Further, that the Council desires to express its regret for having granted the permission in question without

previous reference to the Government.

- Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried unanimously.
- 5. The Auditor General's report for 1896 was laid on the table.
- 6. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to April 30, 1897, and Progres Report of Work done during April, 1897, were laid on the table.
 - 7. The Auditor General's remarks on the accounts for December, 1896, were laid on the table.
- 8. The City Analyst's report on the town water for April, 1897, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
- 9. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gunpowder for May, 1897, were laid on the table.
- 10. An application dated April 20, 1897, from Mr. R. Skelton, Superintendent of Works, for extension of his leave on half salary for two months, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the leave applied for be granted."

The Hon. Sir W. R. Kynsey seconded.—Carried unanimously.

MUNICIPALITY OF KANDY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall on Saturday, March 20, 1897, at 8.30 o'clock a.m.

Present:—Hon. Allanson Bailey, Chairman; Dr. Frederick Keyt; A. Murray, Esq.; R. W. Jonklaas, Esq.; C. Vanderwall, Esq.; Alexander Phllip, Esq., J. H. Sproule, Esq.

- 1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on February 20 were read and confirmed.
- 2. The following documents were laid on the table:—Statement of Receipts and Disbursements on account of the Municipal Fund from end of 1896 to February 28, 1897; separate statements in respect of the General Revenue, Police Assessment, and Water-rate accounts during the same period; Return of Work done by the Municipal Magistrate and of Cases instituted by the srveral Inspectors during the month of February; and Health Officer's Reports for January and February. The usual Progress Report of Work done by the Public Works Officer was not furnished for February.

Resolved,—That the several statements, as required by section 90 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, be forwarded, with the Minutes of this Meeting, to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the Government Gazette.

- 3. The recommendation of the Standing Committee that Mr. Weerasinghe, Storekeeper, be granted an addition of Rs. 5 a month to his salary in consideration of his long service of thirty-one years, was approved.
- 4. A recommendation of the Standing Committee in connection with the water supply was considered, and on the motion of Mr. Vanderwall, seconded by Mr. Jonklaas, it was resolved that a Special Committee of the Council be appointed to inquire into all questions, to collate and have printed all papers, documents, and plans, &c., relating to the subject, and to report to the Council. The following Special Committee was nominated:—The Chairman, Mr. Murray, Dr. Keyt, Mr. Philip.

- 5. Mr. Philip asked, pursuant to notice, what the position was of the scheme for widening the Victoria drive The Chairman replied that it was proposed to remove the island at the head of the lake and the silt round it, using the earth partly for the widening of Victoria drive and partly for filling up low grounds between the Club and the Malay mosque. An application for a loan from Government for the purpose was still under consideration.
- 6. Mr. Philip moved, pursuant to notice, the appointment of a Special Committee of the Council to consider and report as to the advisability of having the narrow passage or roadway immediately before coming to the United Service Library rebuilt, the Kandyan wall being set back in a line with the Kandyan wall on the bund, and the Kandyan wall being further carried round to the library buildings, thus providing not only ample carriageway in lieu of the present single-file opening, but completing the bund promenade and square to the general public convenience. The following Special Committee was nominated:—The Chairman, Mr. Murray, Mr. Jonklaas, and Mr. Philip.
- 7. Mr. Philip moved, pursuant to notice, having with the leave of the Council amended the latter part of the motion of which he had given notice, "that the Chairman be asked, in terms of section 204, Municipal Councils' Ordinance, to have immediate steps taken to provide and maintain duplicate public latrines and urinals at the various situations where they are now erected, and that the question of having similar latrines and urinals erected within some of the crowded alleys of Colombo street and elsewhere be referred to the Health Office for early report."

 Seconded by Mr. Sproule and carried.
- 8. Considered recommendation of the Standing Committee regarding the electric lighting of Kandy as follows:—That the tender of the Colombo Gas Company be approved of, and that it be recommended for the Council's acceptance.

Moved by Mr. Sproule, and seconded by Mr. Vanderwall, "that the recommendation be approved."—Carried unanimously.

9. Read report of the Special Committee appointed to report on (1) the side drains of Katugastota road; (2) the improvement of the water-course about the railway viaduct at Mahaiyawa; and (3) the widening of the road to the gravel pit and the lengthening of the brick barrel drain.

It was resolved, on the motion of Mr. Vanderwall, seconded by Mr. Jonklass, that the report of the Special Committee be adopted, and that it be sent to the Standing Committee to have effect given to it.

Sanitary Officer's Report for February, 1897:

I have the honour to forward the monthly sanitary report, and would beg to inform you that the sanitation of the town is still very bad. By-laws have been passed for the bakeries, but they require to be enforced. All dairies, cattle stands, &c., are in a most insanitary condition, and require in every case being put and kept in the state stands, etc., are in a most insamary condition, and require in every case stands proved the state of repair and cleanliness required by the Municipal by-laws.

The public latrines require to be doubled, proper buckets supplied, the night soil properly removed under suitable supervision and deposited in the trench now being prepared for it.

The scavenging carts, in every case, are in bad repair.

The night soil carts are unsuitable and insufficient in number.

The night soil carts are unsuitable and insufficient in number.

The defects in all houses and alleys noted by the Inspectors require to be remedied at once. Some of these have been noted for months, and nothing has been done towards remedying them. As far as possible, the dry-earth system should be gradually introduced.

The surface drains and barrel drains all over the town are in bad repair, and require to be repaired, opened

beds are in use

up, and cement rendered, and thoroughly cleansed.

The slaughter-houses are in bad repair; sufficient buckets are not supplied; proper supervision is not exercised over them, nor is blood refuse, &c., properly removed. I would beg to recommend that the slaughter-house for goats be pulled down, the ground round it cleansed, and a new one built in a suitable place.

The water supply of the town comes through well-manured tea estates, also through cooly lines-no filter

No infectious diseases are at present prevalent.
