- 2. By his order, made under section 3 (1) (d) of the aforesaid Act, dated 26th July, 1962, the Commissioner of Labour referred the above dispute to me for settlement by arbitration. According to the statement of the Commissioner of Labour, appended to his order, the matter in dispute between the parties is whether the refusal of work to P. Muniyandy by the Management of Dotel Oya Estate, Dolosbage is justified and to what relief he is entitled
- 3. An inquiry was held on the 11th, 20th and 25th September, 1962. The Congress was represented by Mr. Advocate T. W. Rajaratnam, instructed by Mr. Naliasekeram, while the Superintendent appeared in person on the first two dates and on the th.rd date was represented by Mr. Advocate A. C. Krishna Rajah, instructed by Messrs. D. L. & F. de Saram.
- 4. On the 11th September Mr. Advocate Rajaratnam explained to Court that owing to some mis-reading of the notice he had been retained by the Congress only that morning and applied for a fresh date. He apologised for the inconvenience caused and volunteered to pay costs of the day to the Superintendent. The Superintendent agreed to this request and further hearing was adjourned for the 20th September, 1962.
- 5. On the 20th September, Mr. Perera, the Superintendent, stated that there was a possibility of settling this dispute on the next date of hearing and asked that Court be adjourned till after the 23rd September, 1962, when Dr. H. V. J. Fernando, the proprietor of the estate, who was on that day away on official duty, would be present. Mr. Perera agreed to waive the costs offered to him on the first date as he himself was now asking for a postponement of the hearing. Mr. Rajaratnam agreed and said that he thought the matter could be settled on the next date when Dr Fernando was present. Mr. Rajaratnam also stated that he did not oppose a date since there is every possibility of settling the matter in dispute. The hearing was therefore adjourned for the 25th.
- 6. On the 25th September when the parties met. after a brief discussion in Court Mr. Rajaratnam applied for a short adjournment to enable the parties to negotiate a settlement. Mr. Krishna Rajah did not oppose and Court allowed the adjournment.
- 7. When the Court resumed, after the short adjournment, the parties indicated to Court that they had arrived at a settlement of the dispute on the following terms:—

- (3) This sum of Rs. 100 is to be deposited with the Labour Officer, Nawalapitiya, before the 10th October, 1962.
