#### The Award

The Award

This award relates to an industrial dispute between the Tea, Rubber, Coconut and General Produce Workers' Union (hereinafter referred to as "the union") and Brooke Bond (Ceylon) Ltd., (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") and is made under section 17 of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments, Ceylon (Revised Edition 1956) as amended by Industrial Disputes (Amendment) Acts, Nos. 14 and 62 of 1957. By Order made under section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, the Honourable the Minister of Labour and Nationalized Services referred the dispute to this Tribunal for settlement by arbitration. The statement of the Commissioner of Labour accompanying the Minister's Order gives the matter in dispute between the parties to be whether the non-employment of Mr. B. M. Martin Singho alias K. L. Ariyasena is justified and to what relief he is entitled.

- 2. Mr. B. M. Martin Singho, who was suspended from work on 17th July, 1961, was, after inquiry, summarily dismissed from employment. He was stated to have been found guilty at trom employment. He was stated to have been found guilty at the inquiry of having been insubordinate to and having intimidated a superior. The workman's past conduct was also stated to have been bad. The union's position was that the charges were not established at the domestic inquiry and that the workman was actually not guilty of those charges. The union did not allege prejudice on that part of the inquiring officer or victimization by the company.
- 3. The matter proceeded to inquiry and after the workman concerned had been examined and partly cross-examined the parties came to a settlement.
- At the hearing Mr. Advocate Vernon Wijetunga instructed by Messrs. Julius and Creasy, Solicitors and Proctors, appeared for the company and the union was represented by Mr. Vernon de Livera.

The terms of settlement the parties came to are as follows:-"The dismissal of B. M. Martin Singho alias K. L. Ariyasena will stand.

- The company, without admitting any liability, agrees to pay Rs. 125/- ex-gratia, to the workman. The workman agrees to accept this sum in settlement of all his claim.
- "When the workman receives the sum of Rs. 125/- he will have no further claims against the company in respect of his employment or the termination of his employment.
- "Payment will be made on such date and in such manner as decided by the Tribunal".

The settlement is just and equitable and I make award in terms of it. The sum of Rs. 125/- (rupees one hundred and twenty five) shall be paid to the workman through the Assistant Commissioner of Labour (Colombo Industrial Relations), 167, Stafford Place, Colombo 10, within two weeks of the date of publication of this award in the Government Gazette.

#### THE AWARD

This is an award made under section 24 of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 181 of the Legislative Enactments, Ceylon (Revised Edition 1956) as amended by the Industrial Disputes (Amendment) Acts, Nos. 14 and 62 of 1957, and No. 4 of 1962. It relates to an industrial dispute between the Ceylon Bank Employees' Union, Colombo (hereinafter referred to as "the Union") and the Management of the Chartered Bank, Colombo (hereinafter referred to as "the Bank").

- 2. The Hon, the Minister of Labour and Nationalised Services by his Order dated 30.12.61, under section 4 (2) of the said Act has referred this dispute (set out below) to an industrial court for settlement.
- 3. The parties requested that the hearing of this dispute be deferred until the dispute in I. D. 306, to which the Union and the Bank were parties, had been determined. The Award in I. D. 306 was published in the Gazette of 22.6.62.

- 4. The matter in dispute as set out by the Acting Commissioner of Labour in his statement dated 30.12.61, is "whether the non-employment of Mr. W. T. A. Fernando is justified and to what relief he is entitled."
- 5. On 2.10.62 Mr. P. B. Tampoe, General Secretary of the Ceylon Mercantile Union, appeared for the Union, Messrs. Advocates S. J. Kadirgamar, Vernon Wijetunge and Desmond Fernando instructed by Messrs. Julius and Creasy represented the Bank.
- 6. We have now been informed by the parties that the Union is not proceeding with this case. In these circumstances we make no Award.
