THE EMERGENCY (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND POWERS) REGULATIONS, No. 8 OF 1961

RULES made by the Governor-General under paragraph (5) of regulation 23 of the Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations, No. 8 of 1961.

Rules

- 1. Any person in respect of whom an order is made by the Permanent Secretary to the Ministry of Defence and External Affairs under paragraph (1) of regulation 23 of the Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations, No. 8 of 1961, and is carried into effect, may within 20 days after the date on which the order is carried into effect, submit written objections against the order for the consideration of any Advisory Committee appointed for the purpose of that regulation.
- 2. The written objections referred to in rule 1 may be sent by registered post to, or be delivered at, the office of the Secretary to the Governor-General.
- 3. Every person who submits any objections for the consideration of an Advisory Committee shall be entitled to appear in person, or to be represented by an advocate, a proctor or other agent duly authorised by such person before such Committee when his objections are taken up for consideration by such Committee.
