THE EMERGENCY (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND POWERS) REGULATIONS, No. 8 OF 1961

ORDER made by the Prime Minister in pursuance of the provisions of regulation 11 of the Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations, No. 8 of 1961.

Order

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency (Public Processions and Meetings) Order.
- 2. The holding of any public procession or meeting whatsoever in any part of Ceylon specified for the time being in the Schedule to this Order is hereby prohibited during the continuance in force of this Order:

Provided, however, that the preceding provisions of this paragraph shall not prevent the holding of any procession or meeting in the case of which the following conditions are satisfied:—

- (a) that the officer-in-charge of the police station in the area in which the procession or meeting is to commence or any police officer of a rank not below that of Assistant Superintendent has in his absolute discretion granted a permit authorising the procession or meeting;
- (b) that the total number of persons taking part in the procession or meeting does not exceed such number as may be specified by the said officer in the permit so granted; and
- (c) that the procession or meeting commences and disperses within such period as may be specified in the permit authorising such procession or meeting.
