THE POST OFFICE ORDINANCE

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 24 (1) of the Post Office Ordinance (Chapter 146), as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, and the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,889 of July 28, 1948, I, Idampitiye Rallage Punchibanda Gunatilaka Kalugalla, Minister of Transport and Works, with the concurrence of the Prime Minister and Minister of Defence and External Affairs, do by this order direct that all postal articles addressed to any person who is detained in pursuance of an order under paragraph (1) of regulation 23 of the Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations, No. 8 of 1961, shall be delivered to the Inspector-General of Police or to any police officer not below the grade of Assistant Superintendent who is nominated for the purpose by the Inspector-General of Police, to be disposed of in such manner as I may direct.
