A PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Oliver Errest Goonetillere, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Knight Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Ceylon and its Dependencies.

WHEREAS a Proclamation (hereinafter referred to as "the Emergency Proclamation") declaring that the provisions of Part II of the Public Security Ordinance, No. 25 of 1947, shall come into operation on the Eleventh day of November, 1961, was made under sub-section (1) of section 2 of that Ordinance and published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 12,747 of 11th November, 1961:

AND WHEREAS sub-section (3) of section 2 of the aforesaid Ordinance requires the occasion of making the emergency Proclamation to be communicated to Parliament:

AND WHEREAS Parliament is separated by such adjournment of the House of Representatives as will not expire within ten days and consequently, as required by sub-section (3) of section 2 of the aforesaid Ordinance, a Proclamation has to be issued for the meeting of the House of Representatives within ten days:

KNOW YE, therefore, that, by virtue of the powers vested in me by sub-section (3) of section 2 of the aforesaid Ordinance, as amended by Act No. 22 of 1949, I, OLIVER ERNEST GOONETILLERE, Governor-General, do by this Proclamation summon the House of Representatives to meet on the Seventeenth day of November, 1961, at 10.00 a.m. in order that the occasion of making the emergency Proclamation may be communicated to the House of Representatives.

Given at Colombo under the Seal of this Island, this Eleventh day of November, One thousand Nine hundred and Sixty-one.
