THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 40

REGULATION made by the Governor-General under section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance upon the recommendation of the Prime Minister.

Regulation

A person who is convicted after summary trial before a Magistrate of the offence of having contravened any Emergency (Curfew) Order made under any emergency regulation, whether or not such contravention was committed before or after this regulation came into force, shall be liable to imprisonment of either description for a term of not more than three months or to a fine of not more than five hundred rupees, or to both such imprisonment and such fine.

The preceding provisions of this regulation shall have effect notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any other emergency regulation.

In this regulation, the expression "emergency regulation" means any regulation made under the Public Security Ordinance, on or after April 17, 1961.
