THE EMERGENCY (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND POWERS) REGULATIONS, No. 9 OF 1961

·Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 14 of the Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations, No. 9 of 1961, I, Sirimavo Ratwatte Dias Bandaranaike, Prime Minister, do by this Order require the Superintendent of every tea, rubber or coconut estate—

- (a) to exhibit or cause to be exhibited in conspicuous places on such estate every notice, poster or other publication issued from time to time to such Superintendent for the purpose of such exhibition by the Director of Information, being a notice, poster or other publication connected with or relating to the maintenance of the public safety or the maintenance of essential services; and
- (b) to notify or cause to be notified the contents of such notice, poster or other publication to every person employed on such estate in such manner as such Superintendent may deem most suitable (including oral or written explanations by such Superintendent).
