SUGAR (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL)

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

#### Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, John Vincent Gnanapragasam, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Batticaloa District, do by this Order —

- (1) revoke with immediate effect, my Food Price Order No. BT 9/61 dated July 29, 1961, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 12,569 dated August 3, 1961;
- (2) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be, respectively the maximum wholesale prices per hundredweight gross of Raw Brown Sugar and the maximum wholesale prices per hundredweight gross of White Refined Sugar, above which such sugar, further described in the First Schedule hereto, shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;
- (3) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Third Schedule hereto, to be, respectively the maximum retail price per pound nett of Raw Brown Sugar and the maximum retail price per pound nett of White Refined Sugar, above which such sugar, further described in the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Third Schedule hereto;
- (4) direct that, for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of sugar for purpose of re-sale or any sale of sugar in quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of sugar less than one hundredweight gross at a time for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
  - (c) "sugar" shall exclude all forms of jaggery;
- (5) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell sugar which is adulterated with any other articles;
- (6) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader who has any sugar in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for sugar fixed by this Order in that area;
- (7) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (8) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any sugar by wholesale shall, and every person who sells sugar by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out:—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the quantity of sugar sold (by weight);
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of sugar sold, and
  - (d) the nature of transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

  - (c) "sugar" shall exclude all forms of jaggery;
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell White Refined Sugar which is adulterated with any other article;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any White Refined Sugar in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or in that vehicle a quantity of White Refined Sugar in a suitable container with the maximum price for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached in such a manner that the article and the maximum price could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any White Refined Sugar by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any White Refined Sugar by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the quantity and the variety of sugar sold (by weight);
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of sugar sold; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (viii) direct that when sugar is sold the maximum prices referred to in columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 hereto shall include the price of the wrapper or the container, if any, in which sugar is sold.

- (8) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any sugar by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any sugar by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale;
  - (b) the quantity, the description and grade of the sugar sold (by weight);
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of sugar sold; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (9) direct that when any article specified in the First Schedule hereto is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 2 and 3 of Second Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold;
- (10) This Order shall not apply to the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Udahehaheta.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, read with section 3 (2) of that Act, I, Arambamoorthy Sunderamoorthy, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for Kegalla District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date Food Price Order No. 83 dated July 29, 1961, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 12,568 of August 2, 1961;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect, the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross above which White Refined Sugar and Raw Brown Sugar shall not be sold by wholesale in the area mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the same Schedule; and
- (iii) fix the prices specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per pound nett above which White Refined Sugar and Raw Brown sugar shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this order :
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of sugar for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of sugar in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of sugar less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order, no person shall sell any sugar specified in Column 2 of the Schedule which is adulterated with any other article;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order, every trader, who has any article specified in Column 2 of the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such article in a suitable container with the maximum prices for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such containers in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be a standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any sugar specified in Column 2 of the Schedule by wholesale shall and every person who sells any sugar specified in Column 2 of the Schedule by retail shall on demand give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out :
