THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 40)

REGULATION made by the Governor-General under section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance, upon the recommendation of the Prime Minister.

Regulation

The Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations, No. 9 of 1961, are hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after regulation 30 of those regulations, of the following new regulation:—

“ Regulation

or supply
of petrol.

30A. (1) A competent authority may, in any area in Ceylon specified by the Prime Minister by order, issue, from time to time, all such directions as may be necessary for the purpose of ensuring the regulation and control of the issue or sale of any petrol by the person in charge of any petrol retail depot in that area specified in such directions, and it shall be the duty of that person to comply with such directions.

(2) Directions issued by a competent authority under paragraph (1) of this regulation in respect of the sale or supply of petrol by the person in charge of any petrol retail depot may contain provisions prohibiting that person from selling or supplying petrol to any person at that depot except to persons previously approved by such authority, or from supplying any petrol to any particular person or any persons of any particular class or description, and in respect of all such other matters as may be necessary for the purpose of regulating and controlling the sale or supply of petrol at that depot.

(3) In this regulation, the expression “ petrol ” means petrol as defined in the Petrol (Control of Supplies) Ordinance (Chapter 174), and includes kerosene, and the expression “ petrol retail depot ” means any depot, station or other premises at which petrol is sold by retail.”
