THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

SUBSIDIARY FOODSTUFFS

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Cyril Joseph Serasinghe, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Kandy District and Uda Hewaheta D. R. O's Division of Nuwara Eliya District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect my Food Price Orders No. KD—89 dated June 2, 1961, and published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 12,460 of June 9, 1961, and KD—94 dated October 5, 1961, and published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 12,692 dated October 10, 1961;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices which for the time being have been fixed under the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, as the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett for the Colombo Municipality increased by the amounts specified in columns 2 and 3 of the First Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett above which the commodities specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Kandy Municipal Area, the Gangawatte Korale and the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Udunuwara and Yatinuwara in the Administrative District of Kandy;
- (iii) fix with immediate effect the prices which for the time being have been fixed under the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, as the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett for the Colombo Municipality increased by the amounts specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett above which the commodities specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, shall not be sold within the Divisional Revenue Officers' Divisions of Pata Hewaheta, Pata Dumbara, Meda Dumbara, Harispattuwa, Tumpane and the Uda Palata in the Administrative District of Kandy;
- (iv) fix with immediate effect the prices which for the time being have been fixed under the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, as the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett for the Colombo Municipality increased by the amounts specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Third Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett above which the commodities specified in column 1 of the Third Schedule hereto shall not be sold within (a) the Divisional Revenue Officer's Divisions of Uda Dumbara and Uda Bulathgama in the Administrative District of Kandy, (b) the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Uda Hewaheta in the Administrative District of Nuwara Eliya;
- (v) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of any commodity specified in column 1 of the Schedules for the purpose of re-sale, or any sale of any commodity specified in column 1 of the Schedules in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of any commodity specified in column 1 of the Schedules, less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any commodity specified in column 1 of the Schedules which is adulterated with any other article;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has in his possession any commodity specified in column 1 of the Schedules or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such commodity in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for such commodity fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the commodity and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (viii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;

- (ix) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any commodity specified in column 1 of the Schedules by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any commodity specified in column 1 of the Schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- the date of the sale;
 - the quantity of such article sold (by weight);
 - the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (x) direct that when any commodity specified in column 1 of the Schedules is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 2 and 3 of those Schedules shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such commodity is sold.

RICE

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Hewa Dennie Weeraratne, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for the Administrative District of Ratnapura, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date, my Food Price Order No. R/23/1959 dated June 22, 1959, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,790 of June 26, 1959;
- (ii) fix with effect from this date the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett above which rice shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iii) fix with effect from this date, the prices specified in column 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per two pounds nett above which rice shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of re-sale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (v) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article, or with rice of an inferior description or grade;
- (vi) direct that when rice is sold, the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice is sold;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has rice in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of rice in a suitable container with the maximum prices for rice fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the rice and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (viii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (ix) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any rice by wholesale shall and every person who sells rice by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of rice sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - (d) the nature of transaction, i.e., whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

Order

BY virtue of powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Raja Bertram Maligaspe Korale, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Amparai District, do by this Order—

- (1) fix with immediate effect the prices which for the time being have been fixed under the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, as the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale prices for Colombo Municipality, increased by the amounts specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Second Schedule hereto, to be the maximum wholesale prices per hundred-weight gross above which Maldive Fish or Bonito Fish specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the same schedule, shall not be sold within the areas No. 1, No. 2 and No. 3 (as described in the First Schedule) hereto respectively ;
- (2) fix with immediate effect the prices which for the time being have been fixed under the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, as the retail dealer's maximum retail prices for the Colombo Municipality, increased by the amounts specified in column 5 of the Second Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail prices per pound nett above which Maldive Fish or Bonito Fish specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the same schedule shall not be sold within area No. 4 (as described in the first schedule) respectively ;
- (3) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish or Bonito Fish specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of Maldive Fish or Bonito Fish specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish or Bonito Fish specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
- (4) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any Maldive Fish or Bonito Fish specified in column 1 of the second schedule which is adulterated with any other article ;
- (5) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any Maldive fish or Bonito fish specified in column 1 of the second schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such Maldive fish or Bonito fish in a suitable container, with the maximum price for such Maldive fish or Bonito fish fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the Maldive fish or Bonito fish and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer ;
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order " pound " or " lb. " shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight ;
- (7) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any Maldive fish or Bonito fish specified in column 1 of the second schedule by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any Maldive fish or Bonito fish specified in column 1 of the second schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale ;
 - (b) the quantity of Maldive Fish or Bonito Fish sold (by weight) ;
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold ; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail ;
- (8) direct that when any Maldive fish or Bonito fish, specified in column 1 of the second schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 2 to 5 of that schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which Maldive fish or Bonito fish is sold.
