GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

REGULATIONS made by the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 6 of 1897:—

1. The landing at any place in this Island of any goods shipped at any port on the west coast of India, and of any goods transhipped to any ship from any ship which shall have conveyed such goods from any port on the west coast of India, is prohibited.

2. The transhipment within the Harbour of Colombo of any goods described in the preceding regulations, save personal baggage accompanying a passenger, to any other vessel from any vessel in which such goods were conveyed, is prohibited.

3. The Principal Officer of Customs at any place at which any landing or transhipment shall take place in breach of these regulations, shall, unless the Governor otherwise direct, cause the destruction of any goods landed or transhipped in breach of the preceding regulations.

4. The cost of effecting such destruction shall be paid by the owner and consignee of the goods and the master of the vessel by which such goods were carried. No compensation for such destruction shall be paid to any person.
