**THE AWARD**

Colombo, March 17, 1960.

This is an award under section 17 of the Industrial Disputes Act, No. 43 of 1950 (as amended by Acts Nos. 25 of 1956, 14 of 1957 and 62 of 1957). It is in relation to an industrial dispute between the Ceylon Plantation Workers' Union (referred to hereinafter as the "Union") and the Superintendent of Olagoda Estate, Pitigala (hereinafter referred to as the "Superintendent").

2. The Hon'ble Minister of Labour referred this dispute to me for settlement by arbitration by his Order dated 7th October, 1959, made under section 4 (1) of the aforesaid Act. According to the statement of the Deputy Commissioner of Labour, dated 29th September, 1959, appended to the Minister's Order, the matter in dispute is whether the non-employment of G. P. Peiris and E. Handy as tappers by the Superintendent of Olagoda Estate, Pitigala, is justified and to what relief they are entitled.

3. At the inquiry Mr. Advocate Cecil de S. Wijeratne instructed by Mr. Jason Peiris appeared for the Superintendent while Mr. Advocate S. Kanagaratnam instructed by Mr. T. Duraisingham appeared for the Union.

4. During the course of the second sitting of this inquiry the parties arrived at a settlement. Mr. Kanagaratnam, the Advocate appearing for the Union, however, withdrew from the case while the settlement was discussed. Mr. E. T. Moorthy, the Administrative Secretary of the Union, thereafter represented the Union. It was agreed that the Superintendent would pay a sum of Rs. 275 to each of the workers, G. P. Peiris and E. Handy, in full settlement of all their claims in respect of loss of career, gratuity and compensation and will have no further claims against the Superintendent. A cheque for Rs. 550 shall be sent by the Superintendent to the Assistant Commissioner of Labour, Galle, on or before the 31st March, 1960, to be distributed between the two above-mentioned workers, each to receive Rs. 275.

5. The above settlement is in my opinion fair and equitable as well as in the interests of the parties to this dispute. As such I make award accordingly.
