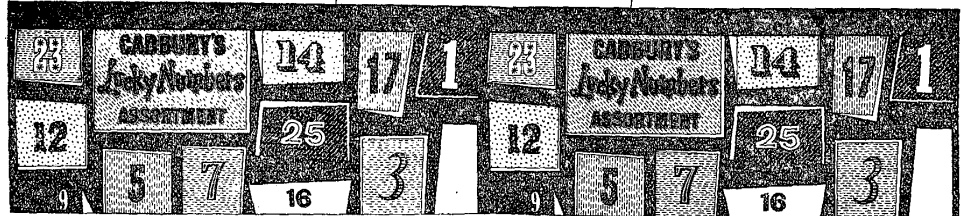

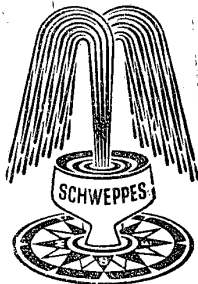

"Improvements in or relating to tools for injecting materials into wood".

Abstract.—This invention relates to tools for injecting materials into wood. According to the present invention an injection head is provided comprising a cylinder for the material to be injected, a piston in the cylinder and holders for two needles adapted to be fed from the cylinder upon needle penetration of the wood and operation of the piston by its contact under pressure with the wood surface.
