Hours of Inspection

The office shall be open to the public every week day, except Saturday, between the hours of ten to four, and on Saturdays between the hours of ten to one, except on public holidays. Applications for inspections will, however, be accepted up to 3 p.m. on week days and 12 noon on Saturdays.

Trade Marks limited to colours

Where it is stated in the advertisement of an application that the mark upon its registration is to be limited to

certain colours, the colours are, as far as possible, indicated in the accompanying representation of the mark in the usual heraldic manner.

Association

Where it is stated that an advertised mark is to be associated (under Section 22 of the Trule Marks Ordinance (Cap. 121)) with another mark, it is indicated by its official number.

Applications in Part A or Part B

Applications for registration in Part A of the Register are shown with the official number unaccompanied by any letter. Applications for Part B of the Register are distinguished by the letter B prefixed to the official number.

OPPOSITION

NOTICE is hereby given that any person who has grounds of objection to the registration of the following trade marks may, within two months from the date of this Gazette, lodge notice of Opposition on form T. M. No. 7 bearing an uncancelled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

"Improvements in or relating to tea sifting apparatus".

Abstract.—This invention relates to improvement to teasifting apparatus. According to this invention, the tea sifting apparatus comprises a frame mounted resiliently on a fixed support, rotatable out-of-balance shaft mounted rotatably on said frame, and one or more sifting sieves slung or otherwise mounted on said frame, means being provided to rotate the said shaft, and for feeding tea leaf to the said sifting sieve or sieves.

"Tea rolling machines ".

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 1, 2 and 3 which read as follows:-

- claims 1, 2 and 3 which read as follows:—

 1. A tea rolling machine having two rolling members for rolling tea leaf fed therebetween, wherein one of said rolling members is reciprocatable relatively to the other and the two said rolling members have co-operating leaf-rolling and leaf-progressing surfaces, the arrangement being such that upon reciprocating movement being imparted to said reciprocatable rolling member the leaf is rolled between the rolling surfaces and progressed intermittently forward by said movement and the co-operating effect of said rolling surfaces in a general direction from the feed to a discharge point from the tea rolling operation. operation.

 2. A tea rolling machine having two rolling members for rolling tea leaf fed therebetween, comprising means for imparting reciprocating movement to one of said rolling members relatively to the other, means for yieldably biassing at least one of said rolling members relatively to the other whereby yieldably to exert pressure on tea leaf fed therebetween, means whereby one of said rolling members is withdrawable at least partly from co-operative rolling position relatively to the other member for feeding tea leaf between the rolling members, and co-operating leaf-rolling and leaf-progressing surfaces on said two rolling movement being imparted to said reciprocatable rolling member and intermittent withdrawal from rolling co-operation of the rolling members taking place for feed purposes, operation of the rolling members taking place for feed purposes, the leaf is rolled between the rolling surfaces and progressed intermittently forward in a general direction from the feed to a discharge point from the machine.
- 3. A tea rolling machine having two rolling members for rolling tea leaf fed therebetween, wherein one of said rolling members is a reciprocatable trough-like member the side walls of which constitute containing means for the tea leaf to be rolled and the bottom of which constitutes one of the tea-rolling surfaces, and the other of said rolling members comprises

a plate-like member mounted above and in co-operative rolling relationship with the bottom of the trough, the said trough bottom and the plate-like member having co-operating leaf-rolling and leaf-progressing surfaces and the arrangement being such that upon reciprocating movement being imparted to the trough the leaf is rolled and progressed intermittently forward by the reciprocating movement and the co-operating effect of the rolling surfaces in a general direction from the feed to a discharge point from the trough.
