

"A ring-type wire cup holder for the collection of rubber latex

Abstract .--The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows :-

1. A ring-type wire cup holder for the collection of latex for tree, made of approximately 2 feet length wire the rubber tree, made of approximately 2 feet length wire of any metal, formed first into a ring 3½ inches in diameter at the centre, on which is placed the cup or shell for the collection of latex, held together by a few twists which also keeps the cup or shell sufficiently away from the tree so that the latex will drip into the cup or shell flowing out of the spout, besides making it firm. Thereafter two small loops some half inch apart, through which a coir rope or yarn could be con-veniently passed for the purpose of fastening the cup holder to the rubber tree. Finally the wire is bent or twisted into two adjustable bent legs or protrusions which provide support against the trunk of the tree at any angle as shown and described in my specification and illustrations, i.e., figures 1, 2 and 3.
