#### THE INDIAN IMMIGRANT LABOUR ORDINANCE

#### Notification

IT is hereby notified that, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by regulaion 1A of Chapter 1 of the regulations made under section 14 of the Indian Immigrant Labour Ordinance (Chapter 111), and published in Gazette No. 7,339 of July 13, 1923, as amended by the regulation published in Gazette No. 7,358 of October 26, 1923, and as modified by the Proclamation published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, the Minister of Labour has been pleased to direct that the quarterly instalments of acreage fees payable to the Commissioner of Labour by employers of Indian immigrant labourers on estates of the description named in Schedule A attached to the said regulations shall, in respect of the quarter ending March 31, 1960, and of all subsequent quarters in respect of which this Notification remains in force, be determined in accordance with the following scale:—
