Order under Section 4 (2)

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (2) of the Food Supplies Ordinance, No. 30 of 1947, I, Wijayananda Dhanayake, Minister of Defence and External Affairs, do by this Order amend the Schedule to the said Ordinance, revised by me in the notification dated January 28, 1960, appearing in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 12,046 of January 28, 1960, by the addition of "Red Onions" and "Rice" and the Schedule to now read as follows:—
