SUBSIDIARY FOODSTUFFS

Revocation Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Donald Maartensz Anthonisz Speldewinde, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Vavuniya District, do by this Order—

Revoke with immediate effect—

- (i) My Food Price Order No. 50 relating to Subsidiary Foodstuffs dated August 25, 1958, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,508 of August 29, 1958;
- (ii) My Food Price Order No. V. 51 relating to cummin seed dated September 22, 1958, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,530 of September 24, 1958;
- (iii) My Food Price Order No. V. 52 relating to potatoes dated October 21, 1958, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,580 of November 7, 1958; and
- (iv) My Food Price Order No. V. 54 relating to potatoes dated December 9, 1958, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,617 of December 16, 1958.

Price Order No. V. 59.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

SUGAR

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Donald Maartensz Anthonisz Speldewinde, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Vavuniya District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Price Order No. V. 54 of November 17, 1959, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 11,960 of November 20, 1959;
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 to be the maximum wholesale and retail prices of white sugar and raw sugar in the areas mentioned in column 2 of the First Schedule;
- (iii) maximum retail prices fixed for each village in the District of Vavuniya comprising the D. R. O. Division of Vavuniya South, Nedunkerny and Mullaitivu are set in Schedule 2 above which price of sugar of any variety shall not be sold in retail;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of sugar of description and grade specified in the First Schedule hereto for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of any quantity of sugar of the description and grade specified in the First Schedule hereto in a quantity of one hundredweight or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity less than one hundredweight of sugar of the description and grade specified in the First Schedule hereto for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (v) direct that no trader shall sell sugar of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any article or with sugar of any inferior description or grade or quality;
- (vi) direct that in every area specified in column 2 of the First Schedule where maximum prices are fixed by Order every trader who has any sugar in his possession or under his control at any place, or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle, a quantity of sugar in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for sugar fixed by this Order, displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the sugar and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any consumer;
- (vii) direct that every trader who in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any sugar by retail shall, on demand give the purchaser thereof, a receipt on which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale;
 - (b) the quantity of sugar sold;
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity of sugar sold;
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, i.e., whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

SUBSIDIARY FOODSTUFFS (MASOOR DHAL)

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Donald Maartensz Anthonisz Speldewinde, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), for Vavuniya District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke from this date my Price Order No. 57 of 12th June, 1959, pertaining to Masoor Dhal and published in the *Government Gazette* No. 11,775 of 15th June, 1959;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross and the corresponding increase shown in column 2 against those areas mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule to be the increased maximum wholesale price in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the second schedule;
- (iii) fix the prices specified in column 3 of the First Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail price per pound nett and the corresponding increase shown in column 3 against those areas, mentioned in column 1 of the second schedule to be the increased maximum retail prices in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of an article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule which is adulterated with any other article;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule in his possession or under his control, at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle, a quantity of such article in a suitable container with the maximum prices for each article fixed by this Order, displayed in figures not less than one inch in height in price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;

(viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule by wholesale and every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the same schedule by retail shall, on demand give the purchaser thereof, a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of the sale;
- (b) the quantity of such article sold by weight;
- (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

(ix) direct that the maximum wholesale and maximum retail price referred to in columns 2 and 3 of the First Schedule hereto shall include the price of wrapper or container if any in which such article is sold.
