PROCLAMATION

By HIS EXCELLENCY SIR OLIVER ERNEST GOONETILLEKE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Knight Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Ceylon and its Dependencies

O. E. GOONETILLEKE

WHEREAS by my Proclamation dated the Fifth day of December, 1959, I have summoned a new Parliament to meet on Wednesday, the Thirtieth day of March, 1960; and

WHEREAS. I am desirous of declaring the causes of summoning the said Parliament :

NOW Know Ye that I shall at 2.30 p.m. on Wednesday, the Sixth day of April, 1960, in the Parliament Hall, House of Representatives Building, declare the causes of summoning the said Parliament.

Given at Colombo this Thirtieth day of March One thousand Nine hundred and Sixty.
