Government Notifications

THE FOOD CONTROL ACT, No. 25 OF 1950

Order No. 144

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (iv) of the Food Control Act, No. 25 of 1950, I, Mohottallage Dingiri Banda, Minister of Food, Commerce and Trade, do by this Order, prohibit the removal from the Customs premises at any port or place mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto, of any rice, paddy, wheat, wheat flour or kurakkan, except under a permit issued by the person or any of the persons, as the case may be, mentioned in the corresponding entry in the second column of that Schedule, and except in accordance with such directions as he may issue in regard to the time at which, the manner in which and the place to which such rice, paddy, wheat, wheat flour or kurakkan may be so removed.

THE FOOD CONTROL ACT, No. 25 OF 1950

Order No. 146

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (vi) of the Food Control Act, No. 25 of 1950, I, Mohottallage Dingiri Banda, Minister of Food, Commerce and Trade, do by this Order, direct the Food Controller to take steps for the allocation of supplies of paddy or other grain or any preparation made mainly or wholly from such grain to merchants and distributors in all parts of Ceylon and to organise and administer a system of rationing such supplies on and after the date hereof.
