RICE

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food) by section 4 of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Kotuwe Muhandiram Dharmasena Jayanetti, Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from 11th April, 1960, Food Price Order No. C. 286 of 12.6.59, published in Ceylon Government Gazette No. 11,773 of 13.6.59;
- (ii) fix with effect from 11th April, 1960, the price specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per pound above which any rice of the description and grade specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo;
- (iii) direct that no person shall sell any rice of any description and grade mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article;

- (iv) direct that when any rice specified in column 1 of the Schedule is sold, the maximum retail price referred to in column 2 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice is sold;
- (v) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight.
