Price Orders

Food Price Order No. 5 of 1960.

THE CONTROL OF PRICESVACT, No. 29_OF 1950 Order

RICE AND PADDY.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Colomba Muhandiramge Solomon de Silva, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for the Administrative District of Galle, do by this Order-

- (i) revoke with effect from the 11th day of April, 1960, the Food Price Order No. 10 of 1959, dated December 8, 1959, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary, No. 12,003 of December 11, 1959;
 - (ii) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price for one hundredweight nett rice or two hundredweights nett paddy and the retail prices for two pounds nett rice or four pounds nett paddy respectively, above which rice or paddy of the first two pounds of rice or four pounds of paddy of the legal ration shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iii) fix the prices specified in columns 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price for one hundredweight nett rice or two hundredweights nett paddy and the maximum retail prices for two pounds nett rice or four pounds nett paddy respectively above which rice or paddy of the second two pounds of rice or four pounds of paddy of the legal ration shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the same Schedule.
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice or paddy for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) the sale of any quantity of rice or paddy for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (c) "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
 - (d) the maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of rice which is less than or more than one hundredweight nett sold by wholesale shall as usual be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per cwt. nett specified hereto;
- (v) direct that no person shall sell rice or paddy which is adulterated with any other article or with rice or paddy of an inferior description or grade;
- (vi) direct that every trader who sells rice or paddy by wholesale or retail in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit on a conspicuous place at his store or boutique a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
- (vii) direct that every person who sells rice or paddy by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any rice or paddy by retail shall, on demand give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of such rice or paddy sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that when rice or paddy is sold the maximum price fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice or paddy is sold;

(ix) direct that in any sale of rice or paddy in 80 measure or 160 lbs. size gunnies the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a tare of 2¹/₂ lbs.

(x) direct that in any sale of rice or paddy in 112 measures or 224 lbs. size gunnies the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a tare of three pounds;

(xi) direct that for the purpose of this Order "nett" shall mean gross weight less tare or naked weight of rice or paddy.

Order

 (i) revoke with effect from April 11, 1960, the Food Price Order No. PL. 15/59 dated December 14, 1959, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 12,015 of 21st December, 1959;

(ii) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the wholesale prices per hundredweight nett above which rice issued in respect of the ration shall not be sold by wholesale to Authorised Distributors appointed for Food Control purposes whose places of business are in the areas specified in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
