Price Orders

Food Price Order No. 1/60.

RATION RICE AND PADDY
(WHOLESALE & RETAIL)

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, John Vincent Gnanapragasam, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Administrative District, Puttalam, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from April 11, 1960, the Food Price Order No. 4/59, dated August 27, 1959, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,845 of September 2, 1959 and Food Price Order No. 4/59, dated July 30, 1959, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,826 of August 3, 1959;
- (ii) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in Column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per hundredweight nett above which rice shall not be sold by wholesale in areas mentioned in corresponding entries in Column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iii) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in Column 3 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per 80 measures nett above which paddy shall not be sold by wholesale in areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iv) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per pound nett above which rice shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (v) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in Column 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure above which paddy shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of any rice for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of rice in a quantity of one hundred-weight nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of paddy for the purpose of re-sale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (c) any sale of any quantity of rice/paddy for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (vii) direct that no person shall sell rice/paddy which is adulterated with any other article;
- (viii) direct that when any rice/paddy is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice/paddy is sold;
- (ix) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has any rice/paddy in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
- (x) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) "pound" shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
 - (b) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart dry measure; and
- (xi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any rice/paddy by wholesale shall, and every person who sells rice/paddy by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale;
 - (b) the quantity of rice/paddy sold;
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice/paddy sold; and
 - (d) the nature of transaction, i.e., whether the sale is by wholesale or by retail.

(ii) The maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of rice less than or more than a hundredweight nett/any quantity of paddy which is less than or more than 80 measures nett and sold by wholesale should, as usual, be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett/per 80 measure nett specified above.

RICE AND PADDY

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, read with section 3 (2) of that Act, I, Kandiah Sivappirakasam, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for Kegalla District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from April 11, 1960—
Food Price Order No. KE 64, dated December 24, 1959, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 12,023 of December 28, 1959;
- (ii) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices "per hundredweight nett" above which rice and paddy respectively shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same Schedule; and
- (iii) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per pound nett above which rice and paddy respectively shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
(a) any sale of any quantity of rice or paddy for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of rice or paddy in a quantity of one hundredweight nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (b) any sale of any quantity of rice or paddy less than one hundredweight nett for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (v) direct that no person shall sell any rice or paddy which is mixed with any other article;
- (vi) direct that when any rice or paddy is sold, the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice or paddy is sold;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any article specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedules in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such article in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (viii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (ix) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any rice or paddy by wholesale, and every person who sells rice or paddy by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
(a) the date of sale;
- (b) the quantity of rice or paddy sold (by weight);
- (c) the price paid for the quantity of the rice or paddy sold; and
- (d) the nature of transaction, i.e., whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.
