THE FOOD CONTROL ACT, No. 25 OF 1950

Order under Section 4 (i)

ORDER No. 147

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (i) of the Food Control Act, No. 25 of 1950, I, Mohottalage Dingiri Banda, Minister of Food, Commerce and Trade, do by this Order prohibit the importation by any person into the Island of any sheep or goat except under the authority of, and in accordance with, a licence issued by the Food Controller.

Price Orders

RICE (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL)

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 4 of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, read with Section 3 (2) of that Act, I, Wilfred Francis Ferdinando, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Kurunegala District, do by this Order---

- revoke with immediate effect from April 11, 1960, the Prices Orders No. KU/4/59 and KU/5/59 dated June 12, 1959, and published in Ceylon Government Gazette No. 11,777 of June 17, 1959;
- (2) fix with immediate effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto, to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per cwt. nett and the maximum retail price per pound nett, above which rice shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column I of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule which is adulterated with any other article;
- (4) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such article in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (5) direct that every person who sells rice by wholesale shall, and every person who sells rice by retail shall, on demand give the purchaser of that rice a receipt in which shall be set out-
 - (a) the date of sale ;

 - (b) the quantity of rice sold (by weight);
 (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold; and
 (d) the nature of the transaction that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order-

 - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 (c) "pound "or " ib." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight and " ounce " or " oz." shall be deemed to be the standard ounce avoirdupois weight; and
 (d) the maximum wholesale price which may be demanded for any quantity which is less than one owt. shall be determined by reference to the maximum wholesale price per cwt. nett fixed by this Order; and
- (7) direct that when rice is sold, the maximum price referred to in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice is sold.

Imports of Wire Nails (Iron and Steel)

Importers are hereby informed that the licence control applies to all types of wire nails of iron and steel, regardless of size or shape and whether the nails are galvanized or treated in any other manner.

IMPORT CONTROL NOTICE No. 11/60

Imports of Textiles-Customs Entries

IMPORTERS are hereby informed that the import documents and Customs entry relating to each consignment of textiles which are under licence control now need not be presented at this Control together with the signed statement in the prescribed form for endorsement but should be produced to the Customs direct for clearance *except* in the case of imports from sources of supply reserved for Registered Ceylonese Traders.

2. As the importation of textiles (except certain types) requires in addition a licence under the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949, the licence obtained from the Controller of Industrial Products in respect of any consignment should also be presented direct to the Customs along with the import documents and Customs entry.

3. Registered Ceylonese Traders, who hold valid General Import Licences, should as usual present to this Control the import documents and Customs entry relating to each consignment, together with the signed statement in the prescribed form in duplicate for endorsement, to enable clearance from the Customs. The licence obtained from the Controller of Industrial Products in respect of these consignments need not be presented to this Control along with the import documents and the particulars referred to at (18), (19) and (20) in the statement need not be furnished in future. The Industrial Product Licences should be produced direct to the Customs along with the entry endorsed by me for clearance. (Vide para 7 of Import Control Notice No. 43/59 published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 12,004 of December 12, 1959, in this connection.)

4. Importers who hold valid General Import (Textiles) Licences should surrender now their licences in order that fresh General Import (Textiles) Licences may be issued them.
