### PART I: SECTION (I)—GENERAL

#### Government Notifications

#### THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS (REGULATION) ORDINANCE, No. 29 OF 1939

##### Notification under Section 6

IN pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 6 (1) of the Agricultural Products (Regulation) Ordinance, No. 29 of 1939, as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Mohottallage Dingiri Banda, Minister of Food, Commerce and Trade, after consultation with the Agricultural Products (Regulation) Board, do by this notification—

(1) Prescribe :

- (a) that in order to obtain a licence to import a specified quantity of any of the regulated products mentioned in Column I of the Schedule hereto, an importer must purchase a quantity of the local products mentioned in the corresponding entry in column II in the ratio, and at the price mentioned in the corresponding entries in the Columns III and IV respectively of that Schedule ; and
- (b) cancel all notifications previously made under the said Section 6 (1).

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Charles Abeydeera, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for the Administrative District of Polonnaruwa, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from April 11, 1960, the Food Price Order No. PL. 16/59, dated December 14, 1959, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 12,015 of December 21, 1959;
- (ii) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the wholesale prices per hundred-weight nett above which Paddy issued in respect of the ration shall not be sold by wholesale to Authorised Distributors appointed for the Food Control purposes whose places of business are in the areas specified in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto;

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Hewa Dennie Weeraratne, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Administrative District of Ratnapura, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date, my Food Price Order No. R/24/1959 dated August 4, 1959, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,830 of August 10, 1959;
- (ii) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per hundredweight nett above which rice shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iii) fix with effect from April 11, 1960, the prices specified in column 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per two pounds nett above which rice shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of re-sale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (v) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article, or with rice of an inferior description or grade;
- (vi) direct that when rice is sold, the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice is sold;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has rice in his possession or under his control at any place, or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
- (viii) direct that for the purpose of this Order “pound” or “lb.” shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (ix) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any rice by wholesale shall and every person who sells rice by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the quantity of rice sold (by weight);
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
  - (d) the nature of transaction, i.e., whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Thambiah Sivagnanam, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Hambantota District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect my Food Price Order No. H 29' dated August 11, 1959, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,833 of August 14, 1959, which was restored by para. 2 (b) of my Food Price Order No. H 34 dated December 30, 1959, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 12,029 of January 4, 1960 ;
- (ii) revoke with immediate effect my Food Price Order No. H 28' dated July 15, 1959, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,811 of July 17, 1959 ;
- (iii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per one hundredweight (cwt.) nett above which rice shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto ;
- (iv) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per pound (lb.) nett above which rice shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto ;
- (v) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale or any sale of rice in a quantity of one hundred-weight nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice less than one hundredweight nett for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
  - (c) "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight ;
- (vi) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article ;
- (vii) direct that when any rice is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice is sold ;
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any rice in his possession or under his control in any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or in that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area ; and
- (ix) direct that every person who sells rice by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any rice by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of sale ;
  - (b) the quantity of rice sold (by weight) ;
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold ; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

## RICE (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL)

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

## Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Gardiye Punchihewage Buddhadasa de Silva, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Kalutara District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from April 11, 1960, my Price Order No. K.L. 60 of November 18, 1959, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,978 of November 25, 1959, and Price Order No. K.L. 57 of June 14, 1959, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,792 of June 29, 1959, so far as they relate to the maximum retail prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Second Schedule of this Price Order;
- (ii) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the first Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per hundredweight nett above which rice shall not be sold by wholesale in the area mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iii) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per pound nett above which rice shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of any rice for the purpose of resale, or any sale of rice in a quantity of one hundredweight nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice less than one hundredweight nett for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (v) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article, or with rice of an inferior description or grade;
- (vi) direct that every trader who sells rice (by wholesale or retail) in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the two Schedules hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous place at his store or boutique a notice in which shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
- (vii) direct that when any rice is sold, the maximum price fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice is sold;

(viii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

- (a) "pound" shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (b) the maximum price which may be demanded for any quantity of rice which is less than one hundredweight or less than one pound shall be determined by reference to the maximum retail price fixed by this Order;

(ix) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells rice by wholesale shall, and every person who sells rice by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof, a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of sale;
- (b) the quantity of the rice sold;
- (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.
