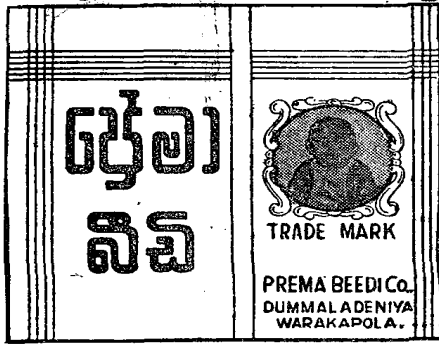
NOTICE is hereby given that any person who has grounds of objection to the registration of the following trade marks may, within two months from the date of this Gazette, lodge notice of Opposition on form T. M. No. 7 bearing an uncanceled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration so as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expense of preparing the Notice of Opposition is incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an Opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.

Abstracts:—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1. Process for the preparation of compounds of the following general formula—



where Ar, R, I, II, III and IV have the following meaning:—

Ar = aromatic radical, simple or substituted with one or more substituents: such substituents can be NO₂, halogens, OH (free, esterified or etherified), NH₂ (free, salified or substituted with alkyl or acyl radicals), COOH (free or esterified with alkyl radicals);

I = -O-, -S-, -SO-, -O₂-, (CH₂)_n (where n = 1-3), -CO-, -NH-, -O(CH₂)_xO- (where x = 2-12), -CH₂-O-CH₂-;

with an amine as R NH₂ in order to obtain the corresponding base of Schiff which is submitted to a catalytic hydrogenation and the obtained secondary amine or one of its salts is transformed into the corresponding amide by means of any acylating agent, containing halogens in the alkyl radical.
