**IMPORT CONTROL NOTICE No. 22/60**  
**Imports of Aluminium Foil and Lining**

IMPORTERS are informed that a licence is now required for the importation of aluminium foil and lining from any source of supply. The same requirement applies to General Import Licence holders who should now obtain individual import licences to import such goods.

2. A statement of confirmed outstanding orders supported by documentary evidence should be forwarded to this Control within seven days of the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* giving (1) date of Order, (2) date of confirmation, (3) country of origin, (4) quantity in cwt. and (5) c. i. f. value in Rupees.

3. Separate statements in respect of imports of aluminium foil and lining in 1959 and 1960 (up to date) supported by Customs stamped entries and invoices should also be forwarded to this Control within 14 days from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* giving (1) entry number and date, (2) country of origin, (3) quantity in cwt. and (4) c. i. f. value in Rupees.

4. Importers are warned against placing orders for supplies from any source or getting shipments effected after this date against any outstanding orders, without being in prior possession of relevant import licences issued by this Control. This requirement will be strictly adhered to.

5. Importers are also requested to state on their covering letters when forwarding their statements called for in para 2 or 3 above whether they import aluminium foil and lining for sale or for use in their factories and workshops. In the latter case they should give the following information:—

- (1) Name and address of the factory or workshop.
- (2) Type of the commodity manufactured.
- (3) Annual requirements (in cwt.) of aluminium foil and lining for use in the manufactory.
- (4) If imports are to be made from “Ceylonised Countries” state General Import Licence No.

**IMPORT CONTROL NOTICE No. 21/60**  
**Imports of Towels and Towelling**

IMPORTERS are informed that a licence is now required for the importation of towels and towelling of cotton, artificial-silk, rayon or synthetic-fibre from any source of supply. The same requirement applies to General Import Licence holders who should now obtain individual import licences to import such goods.

2. Separate statements of imports of (1) towels and towelling of cotton and (2) towels and towelling of artificial-silk, rayon or synthetic-fibre in 1957, 1958, 1959 and 1960 (up to date) supported by Customs stamped entries and invoices should be forwarded to this Control within 10 days from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* giving (1) entry number and date, (2) country of origin, (3) quantity in numbers or yards and (4) c. i. f. value in Rupees.

3. Importers are warned against placing orders for supplies from any source or getting shipment effected after this date against any outstanding orders. Licences will only be granted in cases where Letters of Credit have been opened or where goods have been shipped on or before the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*.

4. Importers are requested to cancel all their outstanding orders immediately. Where orders cannot be cancelled they should instruct their suppliers not to ship any goods until they obtain licences against any allocations that may be granted them.
