GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE “CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE”

1. **Allowances**—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

2. **Conditions of Service**.—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

3. **Terms of Engagement**.—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution in either case will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

4. **New Entrant Officers**—

(i) The period of probation/trial of “New Entrant Officers” appointed to pensionable posts/non-pensionable posts, as the case may be, shall be 3 years unless a longer period is prescribed in respect of any posts.

(ii) “New Entrant Officers” will be required to comply with any rules already made or that may hereafter be made for giving effect to the Language Policy of the Government and in particular for implementing the provisions of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956.

(iii) (a) These officers will be required to acquire proficiency in Sinhala during their period of probation/trial.

(b) Their confirmation, at the expiry of the period of probation/trial, will depend, *inter alia*, on the passing of a proficiency test in Sinhala.

Those who fail to reach the prescribed standard of proficiency in Sinhala during their period of probation/trial are liable to be discontinued, but discontinuance may be deferred if the appointing authority is satisfied that a genuine attempt had been made to acquire proficiency in the Official Language. Loss of seniority may be waived at the discretion of the appropriate authority if the officer passes the test within a reasonable time after the due date.

(iv) New Entrant Officers who qualify for entry into the Public Service through the Sinhala medium will be exempted from the Proficiency Test in Sinhala.

Note.—The term “New Entrant Officers” in this context means officers appointed to posts in the Public Service on or after September 24, 1956, who are not deemed to be old entrant officers in terms of sub-paragraphs 2 (ii) (b) and 2 (ii) (c) of Treasury Circular No. 379 of 23rd May, 1957.

5. **Qualifications required**.—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A “Ceylonese” is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

6. **War Service Concession**.—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty’s Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of each service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest, from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

7. **Other Requirements**.—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service who are qualified must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications, state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

(ii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iii) Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidate.

(iv) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection, and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

(v) Applications not conforming in every respect with the requirements of this advertisement will be rejected.

Post of Launch Coxswains

APPLICATIONS are invited for 2 posts of Coxswain in the Department of Health. Applications which should substantially be on the form given below should reach me on or before 1.9.60.

2. *Salary Scale.*—The salary scale attached to the post is Rs. 1,044—42—Rs. 1,296 per annum.

3. *Terms of Engagement.*—(i) The posts are permanent and pensionable. The appointments will, in the first instance, be on probation for a period of three years.

(ii) The selected candidates will be required to take up duties at short notice and should be prepared to serve in any part of the Island.

4. *Qualifications required.*—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he—

- is between the ages of 21 and 50 on 1.9.60 ;
- is of excellent moral character and physically sound ;
- possesses a certificate of competency as a Tindal ;
- should be able to read and write either English, Sinhalese or Tamil.

Note.—The age limit does not apply to departmental employees already in service.

5. Applicants must attach to their applications COPIES (not originals) of—

- certificate of registration of birth. (N.B.—Baptismal certificate or certificates issued for the purpose of the Code of Regulations for Assisted Schools will not be accepted.) In the case of candidates whose births have not been registered, a special certificate of age issued by the Registrar-General will be accepted ;
- certificates of professional or technical qualifications obtained ;
- three recent testimonials to applicants qualifications, character and suitability to appointment to the post. (Candidates who are already in the Public Service will not be required to furnish testimonials under this sub-section.)

Note.—These copies of certificates and testimonials will not be returned.

6. Applications or any other communications relating to these posts must be addressed to the Director of Health Services, P. O. Box 500, Colombo, and not personally to any officer of this Department.

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING—CONDITIONS OF SERVICE, &c.

Candidates should be qualified in General Nursing and below 35 years of age on 15.8.60. They must be Ceylonese.

2. Eligible candidates will be interviewed by a Selection Board which will select suitable candidates for training. A competitive examination may be held.

3. Successful candidates will be required to pass a medical test.

4. On being selected they will undergo training in midwifery for 9 months at the De Soysa Maternity Hospital, Colombo, if they have not had this training and in Public Health Nursing at the Health Unit, Kalutara, for a period of 9 months. At the end of each course they will be required to pass an examination in the subjects studied.

5. (a) The period of training as well as 3 years thereafter will be on probation;

(b) A New-Entrant Officer will be required to comply with any rules already made or that hereafter may be made for giving effect to the language policy of Government, and in particular for implementing the provisions of the Official Language Act, 33 of 1956;

(c) A New-Entrant Officer (i.e., an officer appointed to a post in the Public Service on or after September 24, 1956, who is not deemed to be an Old-Entrant Officer in terms of sub-paragraph 2 (ii) (b) and 2 (ii) (c) of Treasury Circular No. 379 of 23rd May, 1957) if she has not qualified for appointment through the Sinhala medium will be required to acquire proficiency in Sinhala during the period of probation;

(d) A New-Entrant Officer's confirmation at the expiry of the period of probation will depend, inter alia, on the passing of a proficiency test in Sinhala;

(e) An appointee who fails to reach the prescribed standard of proficiency in Sinhala during the period of probation is liable to be discontinued, but discontinuance may be deferred if the appointing authority is satisfied that a genuine attempt has been made to acquire proficiency in Sinhala. Loss of seniority may be waived at the discretion of the appropriate authority if the officer passes the test within a reasonable time after the due date.

6. The Director of Health Services reserves to himself the right of discontinuance at any time during the probationary period of the services of nurses who are found to be unsuitable.

7. Uniforms to be worn while on duty will be provided free of charge.

8. During the period of training they will be paid Rs. 1,824 per annum as salary together with the following allowances :—

(a) Travelling allowances Rs. 40 p.m.

(b) Washing allowance Rs. 60 per annum.

(c) House allowance Rs. 30 per month when furnished quarters are not provided (if not a new-entrant to Government service).

(d) Shoe allowance Rs. 20 per annum (Temporarily increased to Rs. 30).

They will not contribute towards the Public Service Provident Fund during training. No incremental credit will be given for the period of training.

Nurses who are already employed in this Department will be paid the salary they are drawing at the time of selection and on appointment as Public Health Nurses, their salaries will be determined in terms of F. R. 1120. No credit will be given for the period of training.

9. During the period of training in midwifery and if free quarters are available, at the De Soysa Maternity Hospital, Colombo, the house allowance will not be paid.

10. On satisfactory completion of the training salary will be paid on the scale of Rs. 2,220—120—Rs. 3,300 per annum. On appointment all officers will have to contribute towards the Public Service Provident Fund, unless they have been granted pension rights.

11. Public Health Nurses are liable to serve in any part of the Island.

12. Public Health Nurses should pass a test in Colloquial Sinhala/Tamil before the granting of the first increment.

13. There will be an Efficiency Bar Examination before reaching the step Rs. 2,940, i.e., at the sixth year of service.

14. Candidates will be required to sign an agreement to serve the Department for a period of three years on satisfactory completion of training.
