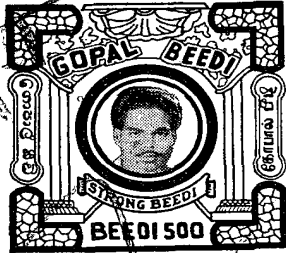

“Method for the production and conservation of metalinsulin compounds”.

*Abstract.*—This invention relates to a method for the production and storage of metalinsulin compounds. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 1 and 2 which read as follows :—

1. Method for the production and storage of metal insulin compounds with increased content of chemically bound metal in suspension in aqueous media, characterized in that high

molecular substances or condensation products or decomposition compounds thereof are added to insulin in any form and combination in the presence of aqueous media, which within insulin or in other manner have added thereto zinc or zinc compounds or corresponding amounts of calcium, manganese, copper, magnesium, iron, nickel and cadmium, or their compounds. The high molecular substances containing

H—C—OH groups and contingently keto groups, free or bound alcohol, aldehyde or carboxyl groups or aromatic groups.

2. Method in accordance with claim 1, characterized in that there is used insulin with over 0, 1 per cent. and preferably over 2, 3 and up to about 8 per cent. chemically bound zinc or corresponding quantities of the other said metals.

There are 19 claims and 9 examples.
