AND WHEREAS an order made by me in consultation with the Judges was published in Gazette No. 12,162 of July 22, 1960, fixing Monday, 5th September, 1960, as the date of commencement of the Criminal Sessions at Batticaloa for the 2nd Eastern Circuit, 1960;

AND WHEREAS it has become necessary to alter the date for the commencement of the said Sessions:
