THE URBAN COUNCILS ORDINANCE, No. 61 OF 1939

Order under Sections 2, 5, 6 and 15

ORDER made by the Minister of Local Government and Housing under sections 2, 5, 6 and 15 of the Urban Councils Ordinance, No. 61 of 1939, as amended by section 89 of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance, No. 53 of 1946, and as modified by the Proclamation published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947.

Order

1. The area delimited in the First Schedule hereto shall be a town for the purposes of the Urban Councils Ordinance, No. 61 of 1939 (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance"), and the administrative limits of that town shall be the limits set out in that Schedule.

2. The name and designation of the Urban Council to be constituted under the Ordinance for the aforesaid town shall be the following:—

" Weligama Urban Council "

3. The number of members of whom the Weligama Urban Council shall consist, shall be seven.

4. The town for which the Weligama Urban Council is to be constituted shall be divided into seven wards as defined in the Second Schedule hereto.

5. The date on which the term of office of the Weligama Urban Council shall commence, shall be February 1, 1961.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ADMINISTRATIVE LIMITS OF THE WELIGAMA TOWN

The area bounded as follows:—

North : From the point where the Gansabhawa footpath from Mudugamuwa meets the southern boundary of the paddy field called Dampeyaya claimed by the trustees of the

Agrabhodi Vihare, north-eastwards along the southern boundary of the said Dampeyaya, the southern and eastern boundaries of Wellakumbura claimed by A. H. J. E. de Silva and others, the eastern boundaries of Kahawattetumpela and Gorakawalakumbura claimed by M. Abeysooriya and others, Midellawalakumbura claimed by M. Abeysooriya and others and Deliyadda claimed by J. D. Weeraman to the eastern boundary of Borala Road, thence southwards along the eastern boundary of Borala Road till it meets the southern boundary of the paddy field called Dangahaliyadda claimed by Arachchi Appu, thence eastwards along the southern boundaries of the paddy fields called Dangahaliyadda, Kora-atambe claimed by W. K. Mendis Appu and others, Tunnodara claimed by H. K. Podisingho, Mullandiya claimed by D. A. Andiris Appuhamy, Okiatwela claimed by K. A. Charles Appuhamy, Ambagahakumbura and Pitavagura claimed by K. A. Koronchi Appuhamy and Kumbalgodakumbura claimed by K. P. Don Andiris, thence eastwards along the southern boundaries of the high lands called Pahalawatta claimed by K. A. Koronchi Appuhamy and others, Pattawatta claimed by K. P. Don Andiris and others, Hapuge-watta claimed by K. A. Cornelis Appuhamy, Pitawalowita claimed by K. A. Charles Appuhamy, thence southwards along the western boundaries of the high lands called Divala claimed by K. A. Cornelis Appuhamy, Tandalowita otherwise known as Ravithaovita claimed by K. A. Charles Appuhamy thence along the western and southern boundaries of Brahakmanagewatta claimed by K. A. Charles Appuhamy and others and Egodahakoratuwa claimed by K. A. Charles Appuhamy, thence north-eastwards along the southern boundaries of PUNCHIKORATUWA claimed by K. A. Girigoris Appu, Kohunaowita and Olageliyadda claimed by K. A. Charles Appuhamy and Kohudurageliyadda claimed by D. Dingiri Appu, thence south-eastwards along the western and southern boundaries of Indipelawatta claimed by S. M. S. Hibushi Maulana, thence eastwards along the southern boundary of Godellawatta claimed by S. M. I. S. A. Rahaman, and across Kananke Road to the centre line of the Dutch canal.

East : From the last-mentioned point southwards along the centre line of the Dutch canal to the centre line of Polwatta ganga, thence south-westwards and eastwards along the centre line of Polwatta-ganga to the point where it meets the prolongation of the western boundary

of the land called Bandarakella claimed by M. Serasinghe thence south-westwards to the western boundary of the said Bandarakella, thence along the western boundary of Bandarakella, thence south-eastwards along the southern boundary of Denipitiya-Gandaharawatta claimed by W. A. Sediris, thence south-westwards along the western boundary of Uswatta claimed by E. Jayaweera, thence across the Galle-Matara Railway track, and thence south-westwards along the western boundary of Pelabandarawatta claimed by M. Gunaratne across the Galle-Matara Road to the highwater mark of the sea.

South : From the last-mentioned point westwards, south-westwards and thence westwards along the highwater mark of the sea, to the point where it meets the Ela forming the eastern boundary of Managawellahena otherwise known as Metigannahena claimed by U. Sina and others.

West : From the last-mentioned point northwards along the eastern boundaries of Managawellahena otherwise known as Metigannahena, Udaten-gahahenawatta claimed by P. D. Teperis and others, and Tummuniyamulla claimed by Dias Abeyadeera and others to the culvert number 88/3 on the Galle-Matara Road, thence across the said road and northwards along the eastern boundaries of Gallindakoratuwa claimed by S. Deerasooriya, Hellawa claimed by P. D. Teperis, thence across the Galle-Matara Railway track, and along the eastern boundary of the paddy field called Manawanagahakumbura otherwise known as Waliwala claimed by P. D. Teperis and others, thence north-eastwards along the southern and eastern boundaries of Medahena otherwise known as Sri Jinendararamaya Buddhist temple premises claimed by the trustees of the said temple, thence north-westwards along the eastern and northern boundaries of the paddy field called Ambagahakanaththa otherwise known as Ihala-bibula claimed by E. K. Pediris and others, thence north-eastwards along the eastern boundaries of Pelawatta claimed by D. W. John Silva and others, Deniya claimed by K. H. Uberis Appu and others, Deniyawatta and Kurunduwatta claimed by Mrs. A. P. D. Abeyasooriya and north-eastwards and north-westwards along the eastern boundary of Patolawatta claimed by S. H. Luis Silva, thence north-eastwards along the ridges across Samara Villa Estate claimed by J. W. Samaraweera and others to the northern boundary of Batawala Road, thence south-eastwards along the northern boundary of Batawala Road to the trench forming the eastern boundary of Talbot estate claimed by C. Jayasuriya and others, thence north-eastwards and eastwards along the eastern boundary of Talbot estate, thence southwards and eastwards along the western and southern boundaries of Epitawatta claimed by M. H. Hinnia, thence south-eastwards along the western boundary of Ridgana-kanatta claimed by W. A. Nonis, thence south-eastwards and eastwards along the western and southern boundaries of Usgodawatta claimed by the trustees of Aggrabodhi Vihare, thence north-eastwards along the southern boundary of Koswatta claimed by N. A. Dionis Appu and others, the eastern boundaries of Acharigewatta claimed by D. W. Kastiranhamy and others till it meets the southern boundary of lot 1 in P.P.A. 1259, S.P., thence westwards and northwards along the southern and western boundaries of the said lot to the land mark on the south-eastern corner of lot 2 in P.P.A. 1259, S.P., thence westwards and northwards along the southern and western boundaries of the said lot to the land mark on the northernmost corner of the said lot, thence north-westwards, north-eastwards, south-eastwards, south-westwards again south-eastwards and eastwards along the western and northern boundaries of lot 1 in P.P.A. 1259, S.P., till it meets the western boundary of Strong's Road, thence northwards along the said boundary of the said road to a point on the centre line of the Gansabhawa footpath from Mudugamuwa, thence north-westwards along the centre line of the said footpath to the starting point of the northern limit of the area.

SECOND SCHEDULE

DEFINITION OF WARDS OF THE TOWN OF WELIGAMA

Ward No. 1—Kapparatota

North : From a point on the western limit of the Urban Council area at the centre of Culvert No. 88/3 on the Galle-Matara Road eastwards along the centre line of the said road to the centre of the junction with Kapparatota Road, thence southwards, eastwards and northwards along the centre line of the latter road to the centre of the junction with the Galle-Matara Road, thence westwards along the centre line of the said road to the centre line of the Railway line, thence northwards along the centre of the Railway track to the centre of the Railway Level Crossing across Strong's Road, thence eastwards along the centre line of the said road to the centre of the junction with Hettiweediya Road.

East : From the last-mentioned point southwards along the centre line of Hettiweediya Road to the centre of the junction with Galle-Matara Road, thence eastwards along the centre line of the said road to the centre of the junction with De Mauny Road, thence southwards along the centre line of the said road till its prolongation meets the southern limit of the Urban Council area, thence southwards along the said limit as far as Rassamuna point.

South : From the last-mentioned point westwards along the southern limit of the Urban Council area to its western extremity.

West : From the last-mentioned point northwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 2—Mahaweediya

North : From the centre of the junction of Hettiweediya Road and Temple Road eastwards along the centre line of Temple Road to the centre of the junction with Galle-Matara Road, thence north-eastwards along the centre line of the said road to the centre of the junction with Sea Road.

East : From the last-mentioned point southwards along the centre line of Sea Road to the southern limit of the Urban Council area.

South : From the last-mentioned point south-westwards along the southern limit of Urban Council area to the eastern limit of Ward No. 1, thence northwards and north-westwards along the said limit to the centre of the Galle-Matara Road and Hettiweediya Road.

West : From the last-mentioned point northwards along the eastern limit of Ward No. 1 to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

Ward No. 3—Pelena

North : From the centre of the junction of Hettiweediya Road and Browning road north-westwards along the centre line of Hettiweediya Road to the centre line of the Railway track, thence eastwards along the centre line of the Railway track to the centre of the Railway Level crossing, across Reid Place, thence northwards across Reid Place to the centre line of the Ela at said level crossing, thence north-eastwards along the centre line of the said Ela to the eastern limit of the Urban Council area, thence eastwards along the said limit to the point in prolongation of the western boundary of Bandarakella claimed by M. Serasinghe.

East : From the last-mentioned point southwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area to its southern extremity.

South : From the last-mentioned point westwards along the southern limit of the Urban Council area to the southern extremity of the eastern limit of Ward No. 2.

West : From the last-mentioned point northwards and westwards along the eastern and northern limits of Ward No. 2 to the centre of the junction of Galle-Matara Road and Browning Road, thence north-westwards along the centre line of Browning Road to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

Ward No. 4—Aluthweediya

North : From a point on the centre line of Polkandan Ela where it crosses to northern limit of the Urban Council area on the southern boundary of the paddy field called Thummodera north-eastwards and eastwards along the northern limit of the Urban Council area to its eastern extremity.

East : From the last-mentioned point southwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area to the centre line of Polwatta Ganga.

South : From the last-mentioned point south-westwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area to the point in prolongation of the centre line of Polkandan Ela, thence north-westwards along the said produced line and centre line of the said Ela to the point where it takes a turn towards the north.

West : From the last-mentioned point northwards and north-westwards along the centre line of Polkandan Ela to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 5—Galbokka

North : From a point at the centre line of the Borala Road, prolongation of southern boundary of Dangahaliyadda claimed by Arachchi Appu and forming the northern limit of the Urban Council area eastwards across the said road and along the said limit to the centre line of Polkandan Ela, thence south-eastwards along the centre line of the said Ela to the point where it takes a turn towards the south.

East : From the last-mentioned point southwards and south-eastwards along the western and southern limits of Ward No. 4 to the eastern limit of the Urban Council area, thence southwards along the said limit to the northern limit of Ward No. 3, thence south-westwards along the northern limit of the said division to the centre of the Railway Level Crossing across Reid Place.

South : From the last-mentioned point westwards along the northern limit of Electoral Division No. 3 to the centre of the Railway Level Crossing at the junction of Hettiweediya Road and Borala Road.

West : From the last-mentioned point northwards along the centre line of Borala Road to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Ward No. 6—Hettiweediya

North : From the western extremity of the northern limit of the Urban Council area north-eastwards along the said limit to the eastern boundary of Borala Road.

East : From the last-mentioned point southwards along the northern limit of the Urban Council area to the northern limit of Ward No. 5, thence westwards to the centre line of Borala Road, thence southwards along the western limit of Ward No. 5, south-westward and south-eastwards along the northern and western limits of Ward No. 3 and south-westwards along the northern limits of Ward No. 2 to the centre of the junction of Galle-Matara Road and Sri Sumangala Road otherwise known as Temple Road.

South : From the last-mentioned point westward along the northern limit of Ward No. 2, northwards, westwards and southwards along the eastern and northern limits

of Ward No. 1 to the centre of the Railway Level Crossing across the Galle-Matara Road, thence westwards along the centre line of the said road to the centre of the junction with Batawala Road.

West : From the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the centre line of Batawala Road to the western limit of the Urban Council area, thence south-eastwards, north-eastwards and again south-eastwards and north-eastwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

Electoral Division No. 7—Walliwala

North : From a point on the western limit of the Urban Council area where it meets the northern boundary of Batawala Road eastwards along the said limit to the western limit of Ward No. 6, thence south-eastwards and eastwards along the western and southern limits of the said division and eastwards along the northern limit of Ward No. 1 to the centre of the junction of the Galle-Matara Road and Kapparatota Road.

East : From the last-mentioned point southwards along the centre line of Kapparatota Road to the point where it takes a sharp turn towards the west.

South : From the last-mentioned point westwards along the centre line of Kapparatota Road to the point where it takes a sharp turn towards the north.

West : From the last-mentioned point northwards along the centre line of Kapparatota Road and westwards along the centre line of the Galle-Matara Road to the western limit of the Urban Council area, thence north-eastwards along the said limit to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.
