THE INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS ACT, No. 18 OF 1949

(Pursuant to Section 9)

NOTIFICATION

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by sub-section 1 of section 9 of the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949, read with section 15 of the Interpretation Ordinance, Cap. 2, I, Bernard Herbert Aluwihare, Minister of Labour, Industries and Fisheries, in consultation with the Industrial Products Regulation Board, do by this Notification amend the Notification relating to Textiles made under section 9 and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,642 of January 16, 1959, (as amended by the Notifications made under the same section published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,811 of July 17, 1959, *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 12,093 of March 25, 1960, and *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 12,117 of April 26, 1960) by the addition to column IV of the Schedule to the Notification referred to the following new items Nos. 56, 57 and 58 at the prices specified in the corresponding entry in column V thereof.

ORDER

Asbestos ridges, asbestos sheets and asbestos tiles, shall be industrial products for the purposes of the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949.

ORDER

1. The provisions of the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949, shall with effect from July 20, 1960, apply to the industrial products specified in column I of the Schedule hereto.

2. Every importer of the industrial products specified in column I of the Schedule hereto shall, in order to obtain a licence to import one or more of those industrial products, with effect from the date specified in paragraph 1 of this Order, purchase one or more of the local products specified in the entry in column II of that Schedule.

THE INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS ACT, No. 18 OF 1949

(Pursuant to Section 9)

NOTIFICATION

BY virtue of powers vested in me by sub-section 1 of section 9 of the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949, I, Bernard Herbert Aluwihare, Minister of Labour, Industries and Fisheries, after consultation with the Industrial Products Regulation Board, do by this Notification prescribe—

- (a) that, in order to obtain a licence to import one or more of the regulated products in column I of the Schedule hereto, an importer shall purchase one or more of the local products specified in column II of that Schedule in the ratio specified in column III thereof; and
- (b) that the price at which the local product specified in column IV of the Schedule hereto will be sold to any applicant for a licence to import one or more of the regulated products shall be the price prescribed in the corresponding entry in column V of that Schedule.

(Pursuant to Section 6)

NOTIFICATION

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949, I, Egerton Christison Selvarayan Paul, Controller of Industrial Products, do by this Notification require every person who manufactures and has in his possession or under his control the industrial products

“Asbestos ridges, asbestos sheets and asbestos tiles.”

to furnish me on or before 31st July, 1960, with a return containing full details as to quantities, descriptions and grades of the said industrial products manufactured and sold by him from 1st January, 1960 to 30th June, 1960, and a similar return in respect of the same industrial products from 1st August, 1960, in respect of each month thereafter.

INTEREST UNDER SECTION 14 (1) OF THE EMPLOYEES' PROVIDENT FUND ACT, No. 15 OF 1958

IN terms of section 14 (1) of the Employees' Provident Fund Act, No. 15 of 1958, the Monetary Board of the Central Bank of Ceylon has, with the concurrence of the Hon. Minister of Labour, Industries and Fisheries and the Hon. Minister of Finance, fixed $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. as the rate of interest payable for 1959 on the amount standing to the credit of the individual account of each member of the Fund as at 31st December, 1959, subject to proviso (a) of section 14 (1).
