WHEREAS by my Proclamation dated the twenty-third day of April, 1960, I have summoned a new parliament to meet on Friday, the fifth day of August, 1960, and

WHEREAS I am desirous of declaring the causes of summoning the said Parliament ;

Now Know Ye that I shall at 10.15 a.m. on Friday, the twelfth day of August, 1960, at the Independence Memorial Hall, Torrington Square, Colombo, declare the causes of summoning the said Parliament.
