### PART I: SECTION (I)—GENERAL

#### Government Notifications

##### IMPORT CONTROL NOTICE No. 31/60

##### Import Control Policy

*(This notice is a guide only and has in itself no legal validity)*

THIS notice sets out in a comprehensive form the present policy relating to the importation of goods. Changes in policy will be announced by notices published in the *Gazette*.

##### Commodities other than Textiles

1. In the first Schedule to this notice, which covers all items of imports other than textiles,
  - (i) the current policy relating to every item in column (a) against which the code letter 'G' is set in column (c) is indicated in column (3) of the second Schedule.
  - (ii) the current policy relating to every other item in column (a) is indicated by code letters A, B, C, D, E, F and X, which have the following meanings:—
    - A. Covered both by Open General Licence No. 1 and by Open General Licence No. 2. Imports may be effected without an individual import licence, if the goods are produced or manufactured in any territory other than the Ceylonised area.  
Registered Ceylonese Traders authorized on their General Import Licences to import these goods, may import such goods produced or manufactured in the Ceylonised area as well, without any individual import licences, in accordance with the conditions relating to General Import Licences set out in paragraph 4 below.
    - B. Covered by Open General Licence No. 1. Imports may be effected without an individual import licence, if the goods are produced or manufactured in any territory other than the Ceylonised area or the dollar area.  
Registered Ceylonese Traders authorized on their General Import Licences to import these goods, may import such goods produced or manufactured in the Ceylonised area or the dollar area as well, without any individual import licences, in accordance with the conditions relating to General Import Licences set out in paragraph 4 below.
    - Established importers other than Registered Ceylonese Traders may apply for individual licences for imports of these goods produced or manufactured in the dollar area only. Such licences will be granted on the basis of past trade.
    - C. Covered by Open General Licence No. 4. Imports may be effected without an individual import licence, if the goods are produced or manufactured in any territory other than the Ceylonised area, the dollar area, Belgium, Denmark, France, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland or Turkey.  
Registered Ceylonese Traders authorized on their General Import Licences to import these goods, may import such goods produced or manufactured in the Ceylonised area, the dollar area, Belgium, Denmark, France, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland or Turkey as well without individual import licences, in accordance with the conditions relating to General Import Licences set out in paragraph 4 below.

Established importers other than Registered Ceylonese Traders may apply for individual licences for import of these goods produced or manufactured in the dollar area, the following items produced in Belgium, Denmark, France, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland or Turkey and brandy and medicated wines produced in Spain :

- (1) Beer, ale, porter and other malt liquors,
- (2) Spirits : Gin,
- (3) Spirits : Liqueurs,
- (4) Spirits : Rum (other than bayrum),
- (5) Spirits : Whisky,
- (6) Spirits : Other than arrack, brandy, gin, liqueur, rum, whisky and rectified spirits of wine,
- (7) Sparkling wines, and
- (8) Still wines other than medicated wines.

Such licences will be granted on the basis of past trade.

D. Imports may be effected without an individual licence by any importer who holds a General Import (Foodstuffs) Licence, if the goods are produced in any territory other than the Ceylonised area or the dollar area.

Registered Ceylonese Traders who are authorized on their General Import Licences to import foodstuffs may import these items produced in the Ceylonised area or the dollar area as well, without an individual import licence, in accordance with the conditions relating to General Import Licences set out in paragraph 4 below.

Established importers other than Registered Ceylonese Traders may apply for individual licences for import of these goods produced in the dollar area only. Such licences will be granted on the basis of past trade.

E. Individual import licences are issued at the discretion of the Controller on the Ceylonised area to Registered Ceylonese Traders, on the dollar area to Registered Ceylonese Traders as well as established importers and on other areas to any importer.

F. Individual import licences are issued to Registered Ceylonese Traders only at the discretion of the Controller,

X. No licences are issued.

#### Textiles

2. (i) Individual import licences must be obtained from this Control for the importation from any source of the following items of textiles—

- (1) Cotton yarn and twist ;
- (2) Banian cloth of cotton, artificial silk, rayon or synthetic fibre, including any admixtures thereof ;
- (3) Towels and towelling of cotton, artificial silk, rayon, or synthetic fibre, including any admixtures thereof ;
- (4) Banians (including singlets, tee shirts, polo shirts, vests, pull-overs, sweaters or any other similar garments) of cotton, artificial silk, rayon or synthetic fibre, including any admixtures thereof ;
- (5) Shirts (including bush shirts and sports shirts) made of any material ;
- (6) Garments (apparel) of any material where the c.i.f. value per garment is over Rs. 40 ;
- (7) Piecegoods of any material where the c.i.f. value per yard is over Rs. 7 ; and
- (8) Hair-cord, satin and crepe (this includes georgette, oriental, sheer, flat, pearl, beauty, crepe-de-chine but excludes voil and palace crepe) piecegoods.

Licences will be issued at the discretion of the Controller.

(ii) Registered Ceylonese Traders holding General Import (Textiles) Licences and General Import Licences permitting textiles may import, without an individual import licence, textiles of any descriptions (including apparel, but excluding footwear) other than those set out in item (i) above, manufactured in any country. Before clearance is effected from the Customs however, of any such imports from the Ceylonised area, the dollar area, Belgium, Denmark, France, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland or Turkey, the relevant requirements relating to General Import Licences in paragraph 4 below, must be complied with.

(iii) Every holder of a General Import (Textiles) Licence who is not a Registered Ceylonese Trader is authorized to import, without an individual licence, textiles of any descriptions (including apparel, but excluding footwear) other than textiles of the description set out in item (i) above, manufactured in any territory other than the Ceylonised area, the dollar area, Belgium, Denmark, France, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland or Turkey. Established importers other than Registered Ceylonese Traders who wishes to import textiles of any descriptions (including apparel, but excluding footwear) other than textiles of the descriptions set out in item (i) above manufactured in the dollar area should apply to this Control for an individual import licence before an order is placed. Licences will be issued at the discretion of the Controller on the basis of past trade. Such licences will not be issued for importation of textiles manufactured in the Ceylonised area, Belgium, Denmark, France, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland or Turkey.

#### Indents

3. Indents for (i) any goods produced or manufactured in the Ceylonised area, or

(ii) any goods set out in column (1) of the third Schedule hereto, which are produced or manufactured in the countries specified in column (3) of the said Schedule, must be placed on the exporters in the exporting country by Registered Ceylonese Traders either direct or through Registered Ceylonese Indent Agents only.

No Registered Ceylonese Indent Agents shall place an indent for any Registered Ceylonese Trader unless the latter is, at the time of the placing of the indent, authorized on a general or individual import licence, as may be appropriate, to effect such import.

#### General

4. In this notice—

- (i) "Ceylonised Area" means and includes Albania, Austria, Bulgaria, China, Czechoslovakia, Formosa, Germany, Hungary, Japan, Poland, Rumania, Spain, U. S. S. R. and Yugoslavia.
- (ii) "Dollar Area" means and includes United States of America, and any territory under the Sovereignty of the United States of America, Philippine Islands, Bolivia, Columbia, Costa Rica, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Venezuela and Canada.
- (iii) "General Import Licence" means a licence issued to a Registered Ceylonese Trader authorizing the import, without the securing of individual import licences of goods of any description set out in such General Import Licence, which are produced or manufactured in the Ceylonised area, the dollar area, Belgium, Denmark, France, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland or Turkey.

A General Import Licence will not enable the import of any goods in respect of which an individual licence may be specifically required in terms of an order or notice issued by any competent authority from time to time.

Before any consignment imported on the basis of a General Import Licence may be cleared from the Customs, the import documents and Customs entry relating to it should be presented at this Control together with a signed statement in the following form in duplicate for endorsement :—

**Imports on General Import Licence**

- (1) Name of Importer and address.
- (2) Name of Supplier and address.
- (3) General Import Licence No. and date of expiry.
- (4) Full description of goods according to invoice.
- (5) Category and Item No.
- (6) Country of Origin.
- (7) Name of vessel and date of arrival.
- (8) Shipping marks.
- (9) Quantity.
- (10) C. I. F. value per unit.
- (11) Total C. I. F. value in rupees.
- (12) Letter of Credit No. and date.
- (13) Name of Bank.
- (14) Guarantors of Letter of Credit, if any, with names and addresses.
- (15) How goods are disposed of, e.g.—
  - (1) If by forward sales, give names and addresses of parties ;
  - (2) If import is on account of any particular party, give name and address ;
  - (3) State whether sale is to be retail or wholesale.
- (16) Give address where goods will be stored.
- (17) Give name and address of Indent Agent through whom this order was placed and his registration No.

I/We declare that the above statements are, to the best of my/our knowledge and belief, true and correct, and that any false statement renders me/us liable to cancellation of my/our General Import Licences and any other licences issued to me/us.

A record of all wholesale transactions of Rs. 2,500 and over should be maintained in the following form in respect of all imports from the Ceylonised area. Where it is necessary for wholesale transactions of less than Rs. 2,500 to be recorded importers will be informed accordingly.

- (1) Import entry number and date.
- (2) Name of vessel.
- (3) Country of Origin.
- (4) Description of goods imported.
- (5) C. I. F. value in rupees.
- (6) Letter of Credit number.
- (7) Name and address of the opener of the Letter of Credit.
- (8) Name of Bank where Letter of Credit was opened.
- (9) Name and address of guarantor, if any.
- (10) Names and full addresses of purchasers.
- (11) Percentage of profit or loss made on each transaction.

- (iv) "General Import (Foodstuffs) Licence" means a licence issued to an importer authorizing the import by him of foodstuffs of the descriptions set out in such General Import (Foodstuffs) Licence, which are produced in any territory other than the Ceylonised area and the Dollar area.
- (v) "General Import (Textiles) Licence" means a licence issued to an importer authorizing the import by him of textiles which are not subject to individual import licensing, provided that they are manufactured in any territory other than the Ceylonised area, the Dollar area, Belgium, Denmark, France, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland or Turkey.
- (vi) "Registered Ceylonese Indent Agent" means any indenting individual, firm or Company registered as such by this Control in terms of Import Control Notice No. 16/56 published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,944 of June 25, 1956. Every Registered Ceylonese Trader is deemed to be a Registered Ceylonese Indent Agent.
- (vii) "Registered Ceylonese Trader" means a Registered Ceylonese Trader as defined in Import Control Notice No. 15/53 published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,533 of June 3, 1953.

5. No Open General Licence, General Import Licence, General Import (Foodstuffs) Licence, General Import (Textiles) Licence or individual import licence issued by this Control shall exempt any importer from complying with requirements in force under any other law, or be deemed to authorize importation of any goods the importation of which is prohibited under any other law.
