 - (c) the lessees shall use the land as a site for a Buddhist temple but for no other purpose;
 - (d) the lessees shall, within 6 months of the completion of the buildings referred to at (b) above, dedicate them by deed approved by the Public Trustee. In that event, the land will be leased to the Trustee or the Controlling Viharadhipathi of the temple, as the case may be, for a term of 99 years.
- 3. The lease will be granted unless valid reasons to the contrary are adduced in writing to me within six weeks from the date hereof.
