#### MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

#### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, February 10, 1899.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated February 4, 1899.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper; the Hon. Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. Charles Perera; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; and Mr. James Peiris.

The Minutes of January 20, 1899, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of January 20, 1899, be confirmed.

- 1. The following recommendation from the Standing Committee of January 27, 1899, was laid before Friday, January 27, 1899.
  - (2) Letter No. 28 of January 11, 1899, from Superintendent of Works, stating that the fruit and flower market will be ready for use from February 1, 1899.

Resolved that the Council be recommended to charge Rs. 5 for each stall. Rules drafted by the Chairman are approved.

Resolved further that notice be given under chapter XIX., 1, of the by-laws in Ordinance No. 16 of 1881, that the market will be open to the public on February 15, 1899.

Mr. Chas. Perera moved "that the recommendation contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee of January 27, 1899, be adopted, and that a market-keeper on Rs. 20 per mensem and two coolies on Rs. 10 each be appointed.

Mr. Walter Pereira seconded.—Carried unanimously.

The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper moved as an amendment the insertion of the words "within the limits of the market" between the words "close" and "than" in rule 4 of the rules referred to in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved "that a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Mr. S. Bois, Mr. Chas. Perera, Mr. Arthur Alvis. Mr. James Peiris, and the mover be appointed to report on the matter of the defalcation by the late shroff, and on the system of Municipal accounts—three to form a quorum."

- Mr. Walter Pereira seconded.—Carried unanimously. 3. Statements of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to December 31, 1898, and for January, 1899, -and Progress Reports of Work done for December, 1898, and January, 1899, were laid on the table.
- 4. Report of the Sanitary Officer for the 4th quarter of 1898 was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
- 5. The City Analyst's report on the town water for January, 1899, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
- 6. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poison, and gunpowder for January, 1899, were laid on the table.
- 7. Mr. Chas. Perera moved that the valuation contained in the Assessment Book of 1898, with such alterations as may, in particular cases, be deemed necessary, be adopted for the year 1899."
