- 1. This is an Award made under section 17 of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments (Revised Edition 1956), as amended by the Industrial Disputes (Amendment) Acts No. 14 of 1957, 62 of 1957 and 4 of 1962. It relates to a dispute between Tamankaduwa Eksath Wee Moll Sevaka Samithiya of Moragalu Nivasa, Rohalahandiya, Polonnaruwa, (hereinafter referred to as the "Union") and Messrs. M. M. Rasheed, K. A. H. Mohamed and P. A. Jamaldeen Lebbe, all of Kaduruwela, Polonnaruwa, the Proprietors of Nuvazia Rice Mill Kaduruwela, Polonnaruwa, (hereinafter referred to as the Mill, Kaduruwela, Polonnaruwa (hereinafter referred to as the "respondents").
