



in which Z is - S - or - SO-; Y is trifluoromethyl; R is hydrogen, halogen, trifluoromethyl, lower alkyl or lower alkoxyl; A is a divalent aliphatic hydrogearbon chain containing 2 to 6 carbon atoms, R_1 and R_2 are hydrogen or lower alkyl or, when taken together with the nitrogen to which they are attached, form a five- to six-membered heterocyclic ring.

There are 11 claims and 36 Examples.
