#### Order

The provisions of paragraphs (1) and (2) of the notification relating to Madampe village area in the Wellaboda Pattu in Galle District made under section 8 of the Village Councils Ordinance (Chapter 257), and published in this *Gazette*, shall—

(1) in so far as these provisions relate to any matter connected with the general election of members of the Village Council of the aforesaid village area to be held on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1966, come into effect on the date on which this Order, is published in the *Gazette*; and

(2) in so far as these provisions relate to any other matter come into effect on the first day of July, 1966.

#### THE VILLAGE COUNCILS ORDINANCE

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Village Councils Ordinance (Chapter 257), as amended by Act No. 60 of 1961, I, Murugesan Tiruchelvam, Minister of Local Government do hereby—

(1) sub-divide and amalgamate, as the case may be, such of the existing wards situated in the village area of Madampe in the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Wellaboda Pattu in the Galle District as are specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto, into the new wards with the limits specified in the corresponding entries in Column II of that Schedule; and

(2) declare that the provisions of paragraph (1) shall—

(a) in so far as they relate to any matter connected with the general election of members of the Village Council of that village area to be held in the year 1966, come into effect on the date on which this Order is published in the *Gazette*; and

(b) in so far as these provisions relate to any other matter, come into force on the first day of July, 1966.

Ward No. 2 Akurala I—comprising the area bounded as follows:—

*North*: Akurala Duwa Road from the sea leading up to Akurala Wela in the Western boundary of Galduwa.

*East*: Akurala Wela and the western boundary of Galduwa in Weragoda village area.

*South*: Northern boundary of Uduwaragoda village.

*West*: Sea.

Ward No. 3 Akurala II—comprising the area bounded as follows:—

*North*: Galduwa Road leading from the sea up to the boundary of Weragoda village area.

*East*: Akurala Wela and the western boundary of Galduwa in Weragoda village area.

*South*: Northern boundary of Ward No. 2 Akurala I.

*West*: Sea.

5. Usmudulawa

... Ward No. 5. Madampe—comprising the area bounded as follows:—

*North*: Usmudulawa-Meetiya-goda Road leading from the sea up to the Western boundary of Purana Wanawasa Vihare at the turn off to Venamulla.

*East*: Venamulla P. W. D. Road up to Hambuwatte Junction.

*South*: Venamulla P. W. D. Road.

*West*: Sea.

Ward No. 6. Usmudalawa—comprising the area bounded as follows:—

*North*: Neegrodarama Mawata and by an imaginary line drawn from the terminal of the aforesaid road, along Sampatiwela up to the culvert at Meegahawatte.

Willigoda—comprising the area bounded as follows:— <i>North</i> : By Usmudulawa-Meetiya-goda road leading from the turn off to Venamulla at the western boundary of Purana Wanawasala Vihara temple up to Maharuppa junction and thence by Meegahawatte road up to Meegahawatte junction. <i>East</i> : From the last mentioned point, by Suduwelikada road passing Madama junction up to Ambalamwatte junction and thence by Usmudulawa-Meetiya-goda road up to the bakery junction and thence by the road running westwards and thence by a line drawn to meet Andurangoda Medaduwa wela. <i>South</i> : From the last mentioned point by a line drawn across Meda Duwawela up to Meda Duwawela junction. <i>West</i> : From the last mentioned point by Hambuwatte road up to Hambuwatte junction and thence by Venamulla road up to the starting point of the northern boundary.
	Ward No. 8. Urawatte—comprising the area bounded as follows:— <i>North</i> : Madampe lake <i>alias</i> Ambalangoda Town limits. <i>East</i> : Western Bank of the branch of Madampe Lake unto Bathing Kraal at Galketiye-Bogahawatte and by the Railway line up to the point it meets Suduwelikada Road. <i>South</i> : Suduwelikada Road leading from the last mentioned point up to the sea. <i>West</i> : Sea.		Ward No. 13. Kuleegoda—comprising the area bounded as follows:— <i>North</i> : By Suduwelikada road leading from Hambuwatte up to Inela culvert and thence by Inela up to the point it meets Madampe lake. <i>East</i> : From the last mentioned point by Madampe lake up to Appalla Duwa fields. <i>South</i> : From the last mentioned point by a line drawn across Galagoda fields up to the terminal Oluwalamulla road thence by a line drawn to meet the Godawana junction. <i>West</i> : From the last mentioned point by Meetiya-goda road up to the starting point of the northern boundary.
	Ward No. 9. Delduwa—comprising the Island of Delduwa.		Ward No. 14. Ronnaduwa—comprising the area bounded as follows:— <i>North</i> : By Godawana road from its junction up to its terminal. <i>East</i> : By Oluwalamulla road. <i>South</i> : By a line drawn from the terminal of Oluwalamulla road across its fields up to the Watch Gate of Galgoda Estate and thence by the Meetiya-goda road. <i>West</i> : From the last mentioned point by Usmudulawa-Meetiya-goda road up to Ronnaduwa junction and thence by a line across Ronnaduwa fields up to Indurangoda fields and thence up to bakery junction and thence by Meetiya-goda road up to Galduwa junction.
	Ward No. 10. Dewagoda—comprising the area bounded as follows:— <i>North</i> : Bank of Madampe lake leading from the point it branches off up to eastern boundary of Idantota temple land. <i>East</i> : By a line drawn along the eastern boundary of Idantota temple land up to Balabokke road and to the Post Box junction at Idantota. <i>South</i> : Dewagoda-Meda road leading from the last mentioned point up to the junction with Idantota-Pansala road and thence by Idantota-Pansala road up Dewagoda junction and further up to lamp post on Dewagoda-Pansala road and thence westwards by Suduwelikada road up to the level crossing. <i>West</i> : By the eastern boundary of Ward No. 8. Urawatte.		Ward No. 15.—comprising of the Galgoda Estate and Colony.
	Ward No. 11—Idantota—comprising the area bounded as follows:— <i>North</i> : Dewagoda-Meda road leading from its junction with Idantota-Pansala road up to Idantota Post Box junction and by Balabokke road up to the eastern boundary of Idantota temple and then by a line along the eastern boundary of Idantota temple up to the point it meets the Bank of Madampe lake. <i>East</i> : From the last mentioned point, by the Madampe lake up to the point it meets Inela. Then by Inela up to the point it meets Suduwelikada road at the Inela culvert near Dummala Watte. <i>South</i> : From the last mentioned point by Suduwelikada road passing through Madama junction up to Meegahawatte junction and thence by Meegahawatte road up to Inela culvert and thence by a line drawn across Sambattivela up to the terminal of Neegrodarama road.
