THE MOTOR TRANSPORT ACT, No. 48 OF 1957

Order under Section 25 (1)

Food Price Order No. C. 400.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

MILK FOODS.

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food) by Section 4 of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Pinnaduwa Arthur Silva, Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order—

- (i) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per dozen tins and the maximum retail price per tin respectively, above which the brand of milk food specified in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the Island of Ceylon ;
- (ii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) Any sale of any quantity of an article specified in Column 1 of the Schedule for the purpose of resale or any sale of an article specified in Column 1 of the Schedule in a quantity of one dozen tins or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
 - (b) Any sale of any quantity of an article specified in Column 1 of the Schedule less than one dozen tins at a time for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
- (iii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in Column 1 of the Schedule which is adulterated with any other article ;
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any article specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle maximum prices for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer ;

- (v) direct that for the purpose of this Order "Pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight, and "Oz." shall be deemed to be the standard ounce avoirdupois weight;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any article specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto by wholesale or retail, shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- the date of the sale;
 - the quantity of tins sold and the nett weight of the tins;
 - the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (vii) direct that when any article specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, is sold, the maximum wholesale or retail prices referred to in Columns 2 and 3 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold.
