GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE "CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE"

1. *Allowance.*—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

2. *Conditions of Service.*—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

3. *Terms of Engagement.*—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution in either case will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

4. *New Entrants to the Public Service.*—(i) The period of probation/trial of New Entrants appointed to pensionable posts/non-pensionable posts, as the case may be, shall be 3 years unless a longer period is prescribed in respect of any posts.

(ii) New Entrants will be required to comply with any rules already made or that may hereafter be made for giving effect to the Language Policy of the Government and in particular for implementing the provisions of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956.

(iii) (a) They will be required to acquire proficiency in Sinhala during their period of probation/trial.

(b) The confirmation, at the expiry of the period of probation/trial, will depend, *inter alia*, on their passing within specified periods of time graded proficiency tests in Sinhala, leading up to the level of the J. S. C. Standard. Failure to pass these proficiency tests within the prescribed periods will result in the non-payment of the increments falling due, until the passing of same. Any officer who does not pass the proficiency tests of the Junior School Certificate standards by the end of his period of probation/trial will be liable to have his services terminated.

Note.—Those who qualify for entry into the Public Service through the Sinhala medium will be exempt from passing the proficiency tests in Sinhala as a pre-requisite for confirmation.

(iv) They will also be required to pass an Efficiency Bar test in the Sinhala language of the Senior School Certificate standard within two years from the date of confirmation in appointment.

5. *Qualifications required.*—(i) Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

(ii) A candidate for any post for which the minimum educational qualification prescribed is a pass in the Senior School Certificate examination or equivalent or higher examination shall have a pass in the Sinhala language or its equivalent obtained at the Senior School Certificate examination or its equivalent if he is a Sinhalese, educated in the Sinhala medium. (This requirement will not apply to those officers who are in the Public Service from a date prior to January 1, 1961 and who seek appointments to other posts in the Public Service.)

6. *War Service Concession.*—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil

Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

(v) be of good character.

Note.—In case of a candidate who is a Sinhalese, educated in the Sinhala medium, he should have a pass in the Sinhala Language or its equivalent obtained at the Senior School Certificate or equivalent examination. (This requirement will not apply to those officers who have been in the Public Service from a date prior to January 1, 1961).

4. *Conditions of Service.*—

(i) The posts are permanent and pensionable.

(ii) The period of probation shall be three years. During the period of probation he is liable to be discontinued if his integrity, efficiency or aptitude for work is not up to the required standard.

Failure to pass these proficiency tests within the prescribed periods will result in the suspension of increment and, if a test is not passed within a further period of six months beyond the prescribed period, suspension will be converted to stoppage, such stoppage operating until the test is passed.

(v) Provisions of Administrative Regulations 120 and 121 will apply if the prescribed standard of proficiency in Sinhala is not reached by the end of the period of probation.

Note.—Conditions (iii), (iv) and (v), above will apply to those recruited through the Tamil/English medium.

(vi) (1) He shall pass a prescribed Efficiency Bar test in Sinhala Language of the Senior School Certificate standard within two years from the date of confirmation in the appointment. Failure to pass this test will result in deferment of increment.

(2) Promotion beyond the Efficiency Bar before Rs. 2,940 per annum in the salary scale Rs. 2,100—120 and 180—Rs. 4,800 will depend on his passing a test in Tamil (Conversation and Interpretation) held by the Commissioner of Examinations for officers of similar services.

Specifications for Instrument Sterilizers

The Instrument Sterilizers to be of the sizes and electrical loading as specified in the Schedule. These sterilizers are to be used in the institutions where the atmosphere is unlikely to contain anaesthetic vapours in explosive concentration. The detailed specifications are as follows:—
